FINANCIAL MATTERS

NEW COMPANIES HAVE DIFFICULTY GETTING MONEY

Few Mining Corporations Started Because Capital is Lacking. Commercial Notes.

New York, June 2.—Pig iron is now being produced by the United States at the rate of 40,000,000 tons a year, which is one-third more than was produced in 1915.

Production of other metals in the United States is proceeding at maximum volumes and development of new mines is not active because the business is so thoroughly controlled that new companies find it difficult to get financial backing.

C. P. R. Earnings. Montreal, June 2.—Discussing the position of the Canadian Pacific Railway, an American authority says: "It is true that of the 10 per cent. dividend paid by the C. P. R. 7's comes from the railway and steamship operation, the remainder of 3 per cent. being derived from special income."

Big Oil Dividends. New York, June 3.—Cash dividend payments by Standard Oil Companies in last quarter will aggregate \$29,731,585, against \$22,297,418 in the first quarter.

Commercial Notes. The great nickel-copper mines at Sudbury are now producing at the rate of \$48,000,000 per year. Of this large output \$38,000,000 is in nickel, \$9,000,000 in copper and \$1,000,000 in gold, silver, platinum and palladium.

A New York financial paper is authoritative for the statement that the Canadian refinery of the International Nickel Company will not be in New Brunswick or Nova Scotia as at first reported, but at Toronto or Hamilton.

Earnings of the steam railroads in the United States with gross earnings above \$1,000,000 annually, show railway operating income tax \$83,101,000 against \$55,581,000 in 1915.

E. P. Ripley, president of the Atchison, in an interview in Chicago, said: "Atchison's gross earnings for the fiscal year will not be less than \$130,000,000 and may be \$132,000,000. Net should exceed 12 per cent. on the common stock."
