By Frederick Palmer, British Headquarters in France, Aug. 28.—"It was a week of gains, and the kind of gains we want," said a British staff officer today, reviewing the result of last week's British offensive. "A thousand yards here and there," the officer continued, "but every time it has meant an advantage on ground we wanted for future purposes. The German attacks, not only been counter-attacked to recover ground they have lost. Not an attack that we made this week has been a gain. As a matter of soldierly efficiency, the British army has never done better work than this week."

In order to hold Thiepval, the Germans, too, must bring up more guns and tanks to blast the British out of their new trenches. Last night the German counter-attack was the heaviest the Germans had made since the offensive began. Until this offensive it was said that you could take any trench at any time with gun-fire enough, but that you could not hold it if the enemy concentrated his heavy guns. Of late the rule has been broken, and the British were more elated over last night's repulse than ever over the gains around Ghinchy and Guillemont today and yesterday.
