

Judge Britton-An Appeal Was Entered at Osgoode Hall.

The following is a copy of the udgment rendered by Judge Maclaren at Osgoode Hall, Toronto, in the case of Way vs. Shaw. It will be read with interest by a large number of Whig readers who have followed the case, it being an alleged mortgage supposed to have been given by the late W. E. Way, of Tweed, 15 W. J. "It is impossible to finish the consideration of this case assisted by the able arguments of counsel without being impressed by the want in almost every specific instance where doubt arises of those corroborative surroundings which it would be matural to expect.

"Were it not that the marters in question have been passed upon by an experienced judge, and that to reverse his opinion would be in fact to pronounce the respondent guilty of forgery and perjury without the opportunity of judging him by his demeanor and behaviour, I would have considerable doubt as to whether the conclusion arrived at was one which this court should adopt, but susimpossible where the issues raised involve the moral character of the actors in the transaction and where they have given essential evidence which the judge has accepted to refuse to give effect to his views.

"These considerations do not go far enough however as to require us to hold that in giving judgment for the defendant he took the mortgage account.
