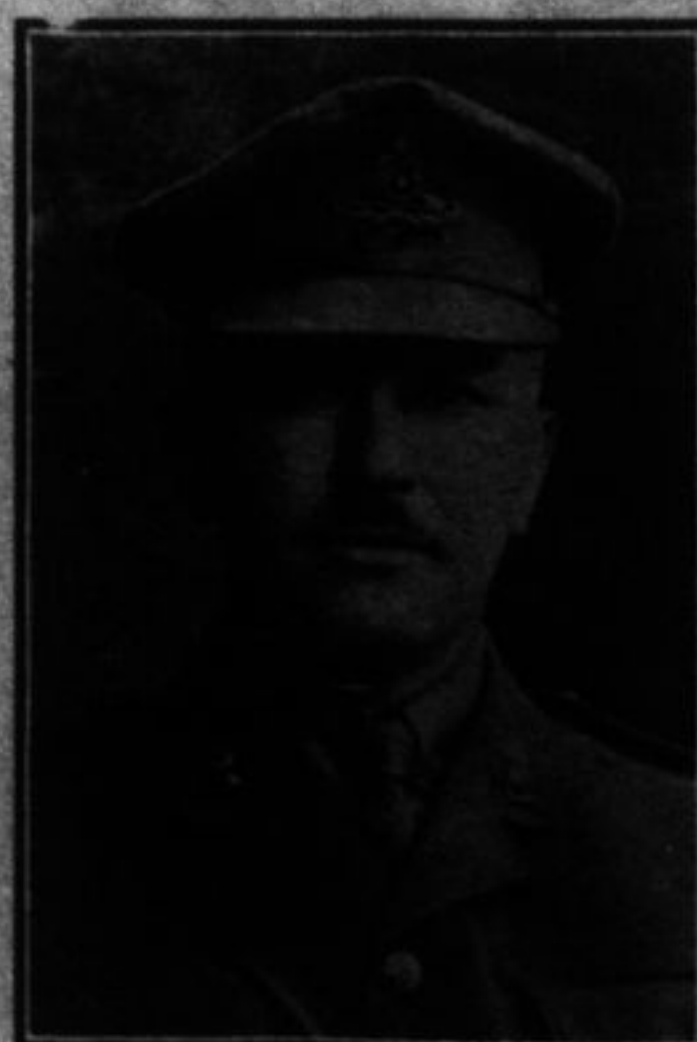

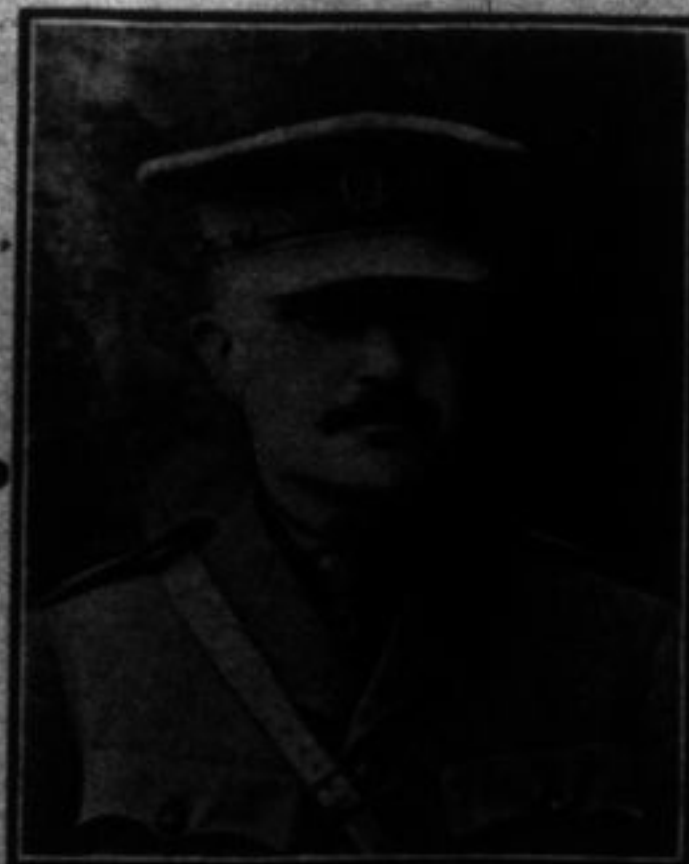

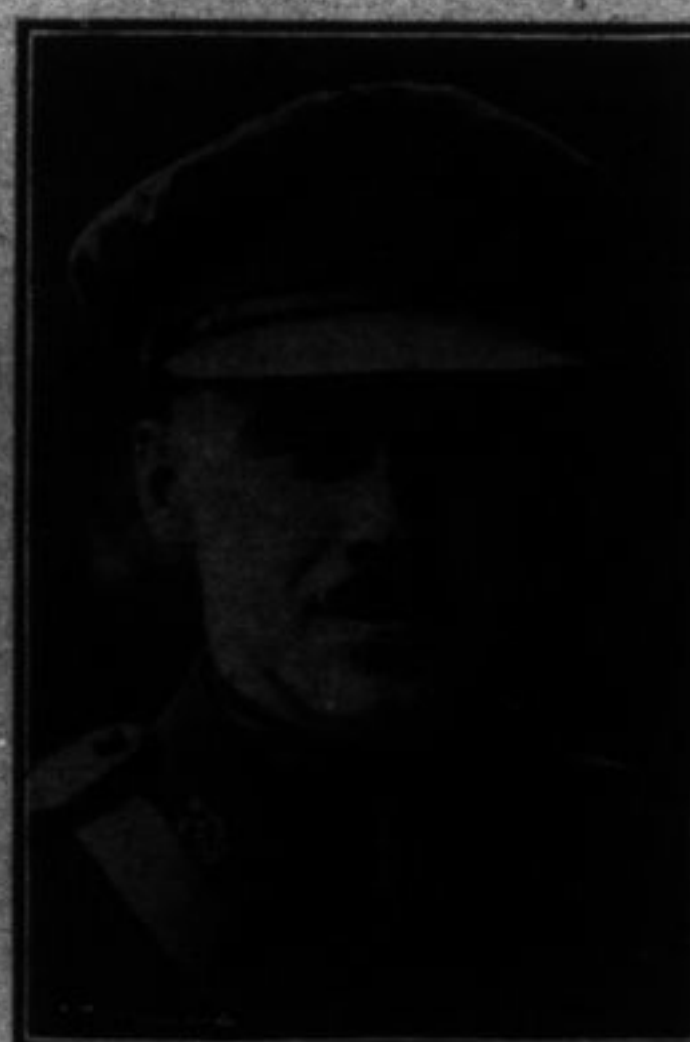
LIEUT. F. E. PATTERSON, 52nd Battery, Kingston, now overseas.
