Bishop Mills in St. George's. The Bishop of Ontario preached a very impressive sermon in St. George's Cathedral on Sunday morning, imploring the higher ideals of a Christian life. His text was Ephesians (v. 17-21). The address was a comparison of the conditions that existed before the coming of Christ, and those of the present day. His lordship explained the various lower ideals and thoughts of the world of that day and how the coming of Christ had so improved them. He appealed to the people to live Christian lives so that the world would continue to improve.

Making Good as Soldiers. A short time ago six inmates of Portsmouth Penitentiary were released to go on active service, and they are now in England on their final training. Dominion Herald Officer W. A. Archibald stated at Ottawa that the men released were not of the class who would be a menace to society. The majority of them had been in the first instance incarcerated for drunkenness.

Chance for Boarding Houses. Commandant of School of Artillery, Telegraph Major Richardson, Sunday night received the following telegram from the commandant of the Royal School of Artillery, now at Petawawa: "If possible will help boarding houses in Kingston, and it will certainly help officers attending the Royal School of Artillery course if a list of the available boarding houses was compiled to facilitate the officers in their search for accommodation."

The mayor suggests that boarding house keepers who are in a position to supply rooms of board send in a statement to the School of Artillery, care of Tete de Pont barracks, stating their available accommodation.

Robson Black, of the Canadian Forestry Association, Ottawa, has made the pictorial part of the lecture especially striking.
