KILLED IN FILLING PLACE OF BROTHER

Lance-Corp. S. Dossese, of Campbellford, Has Fallen in Action.

Campbellford, Nov. 8.—Lance-Corp. S. Dossese, a brother of Lieut. W. J. Dossese, who was killed in action in April, 1915, after making a heroic stand with the 2nd Canadian Battalion, has also been killed in action.

Just the day before his wife received the message from Ottawa saying that her husband was killed, a message came saying that her brother Fte. Earl Varcoe, was missing.

Lance-Corp. Dossese was a veteran of the South African war. He enlisted here with the 59th Battalion in England and was transferred in England to the 2nd Battalion, his brother's regiment. He leaves a wife and two little girls.
