On Sunday the congregation of Cooke's Presbyterian church celebrate the 70th anniversary of the opening of the church, with Rev. D. T. McKerroll, of Victoria church, Toronto, as the preacher for the day.

This congregation was organized in 1844, and was known as the Bagot Street Presbyterian church, its place of meeting being a rough-cast house on the east side of Bagot street, between Brock and Johnson streets. The congregation was only settled a few months in this building when it was burned down. They then secured temporary quarters in the Court House, corner of Clarence and King streets, on the site of the present Custom House

In 1846 the congregation decide to build a new church. A lot was purchased on Brock street, and in the same year the corner stone of the | . church was laid, the congregation taking the name of the Brock Street Presbyterian Church.
