SAYS BODY IS A POISON FACTORY

NEWEST NOTES OF SCIENCE

Cars containing apparatus for disinfecting the clothing and baggage of passengers who have been exposed to contagious diseases have been put into service by an Italian railroad. To enable automobiles to be run on railroad tracks hinged steel rims have been invented that are attached by deflating the tires and then inflating them until they grip the rims. To prevent the formation of wrinkles around the eyes a German has invented a resilient band to be worn around a person's head, terminating in adhesive ends that draw the flesh back. Metal shoes resembling skates, which grip firmly when weight is applied to them, have been invented to enable men to climb steel frames of buildings, bridges and some types of poles.

The Colombian government will establish bacteriological laboratories on the coast and in interior cattle raising districts to study regional diseases of cattle and prepare remedies. As a substitute for the door mat there has been invented a device provided with horizontal brushes to remove dust from the soles and tops of shoes and the bottoms of trousers as well. Different races of mankind can be distinguished by their hair and a French scientist has advanced the theory that there is a certain relation between hair and strength of body and mind.

A Boston electric light company uses powerful magnets to shatter the filaments in defective incandescent lamps to prevent them finding their way into service and causing dissatisfaction. The city of Edinburgh having taken over all its street railways, now operated by cables, a committee of experts has decided in favor of electrifying them, using the overhead trolley system.

As an aid to fruit a Washington inventor has patented a ladder so mounted on a wheeled support that it can be raised and lowered and inclined at various angles to reach all parts of a tree. Canadian scientists after long research have found a way to electroplate with cobalt, at from ten to fifteen times the speed of commercial nickel plating and to produce a whitener and hardened surface.

Experiments in Boston have shown that electric trucks deliver coal at a saving of 3.2 cents per ton mile from the expense of horse delivery and seven cents per ton mile cheaper than gasoline trucks. A London oculist has advanced the theory that if white clothing (for babies could be abolished, in a generation there would be a twenty per cent decrease in the number of persons with defective vision.

In a new rear signal for automobiles the foot brake on a car is pressed and other words denoting direction can be displayed by the driver pushing buttons on the steering wheel. Ultraviolet rays are being blamed for the fading of specimens in European museums and a search is being made for cases that will cut off the rays and at the same time be colorless and inexpensive.

The United States ranks first among all nations in the production of soapstone and Virginia produces twenty times as much as the four other states, Maryland, North Carolina, Vermont and Rhode Island. An Australian scientist has developed a method for the removal of foreign substances from the human bodies with the aid of x-rays whereby a surgeon can see the field of operation with one eye normally and under illumination by the rays with the other. For military purposes a Texan has invented a torch to be dropped from an aeroplane at night to illuminate the ground within the lines of an enemy, attached to which are rifles that are automatically discharged, the affair finally exploding a bomb.
