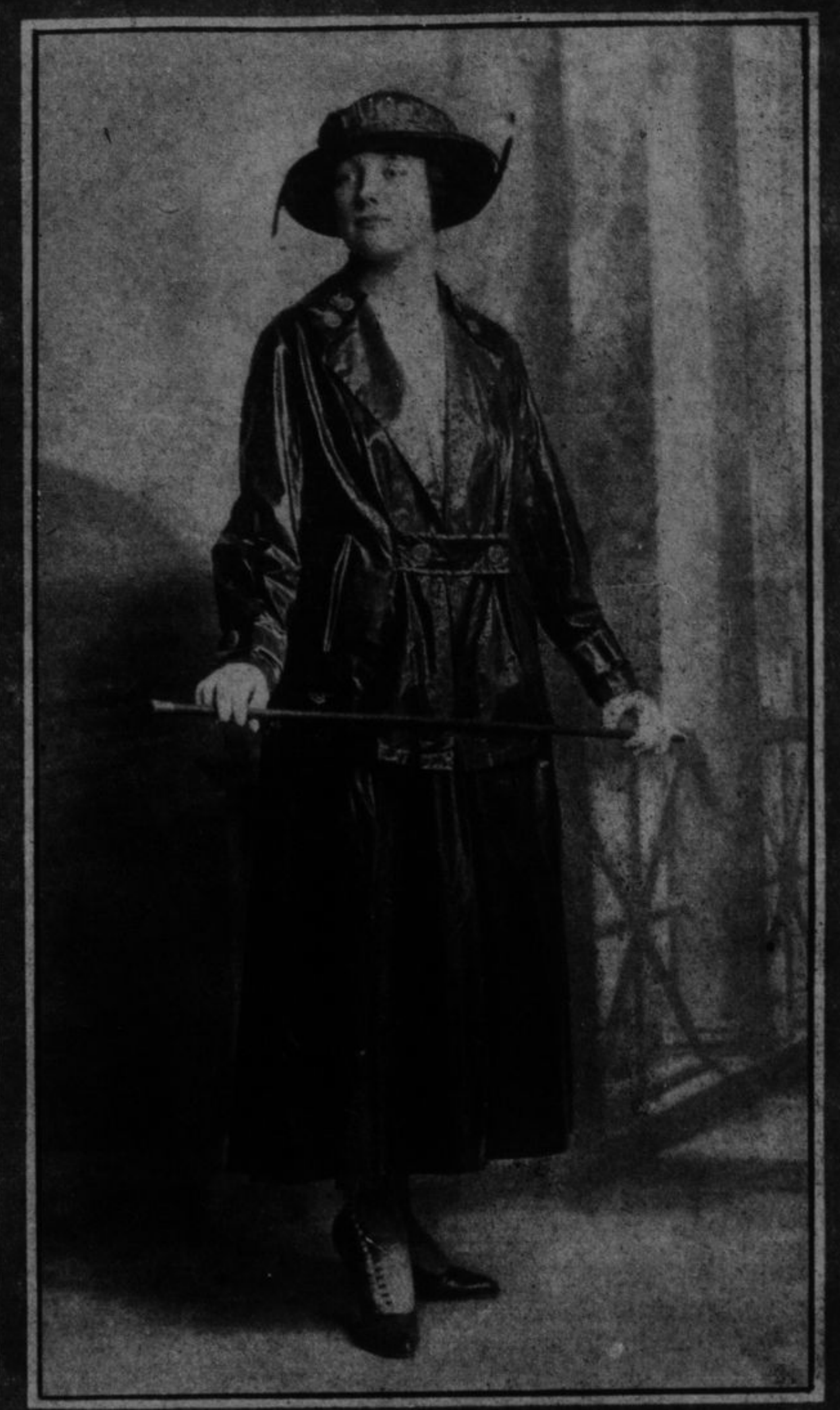
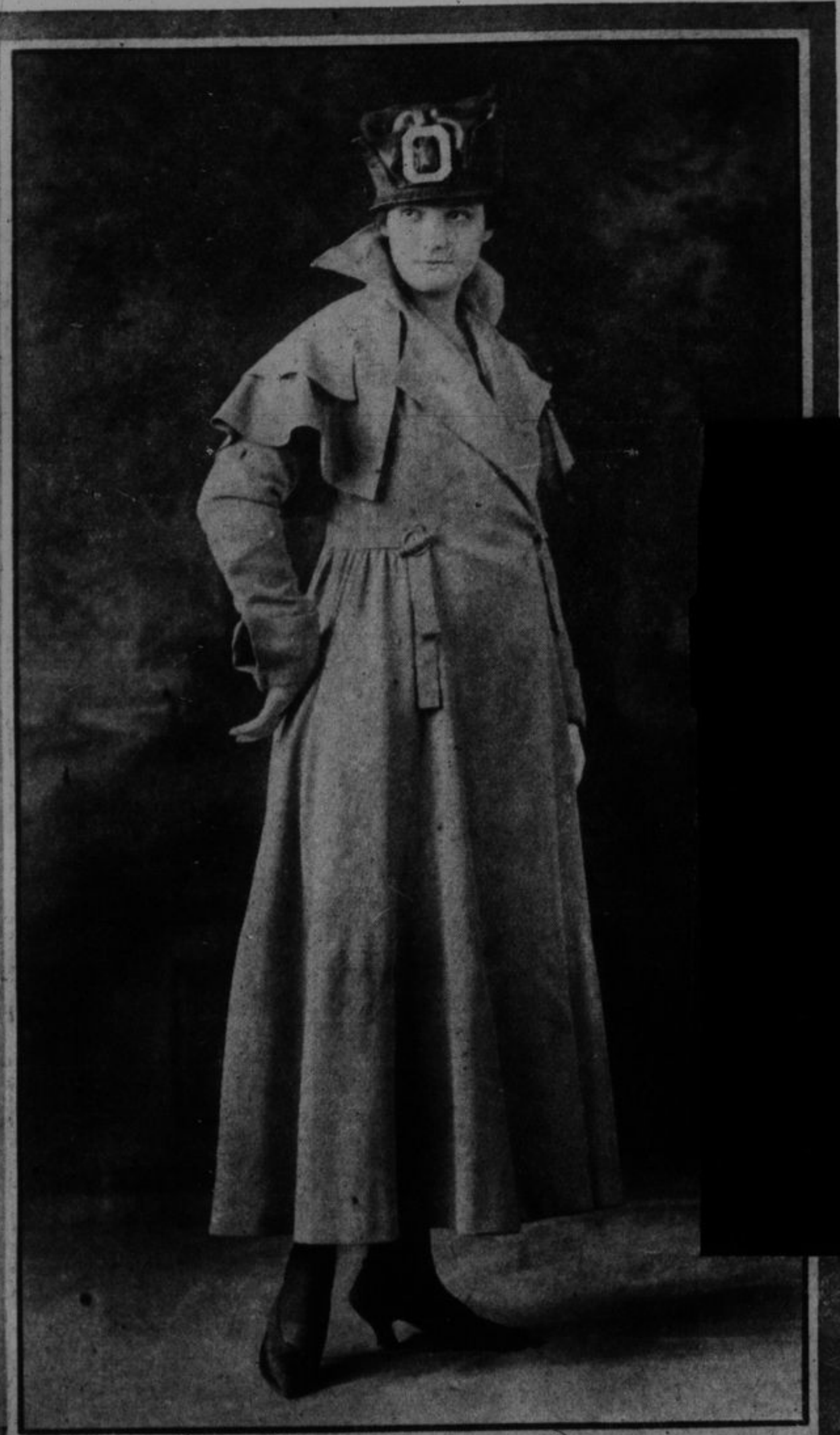


Interesting Fashions and Notable Celebrities
