# APPEAL IS DISMISSED.

Railway Bridge Over St. Lawrence Not Assessable. London, May 2.—Privy Council judgment was given yesterday in the Municipal Corporation of Cornwall v. the Ottawa & New York Railway, the Attorney-General of Ontario intervening. The question left open for appellants to raise was whether a railway bridge, described as an international bridge between Canada and the United States, is assessable by the municipality so far as it is situated within the Canadian boundary. Dismissing the appeal, their Lordships agreed with the view of Justices Anglin and Davies that the bridge is a structure on railway lands and held that it does not make any difference for rating purposes by what title the lands are held, so long as in actual use by the company assessed.
