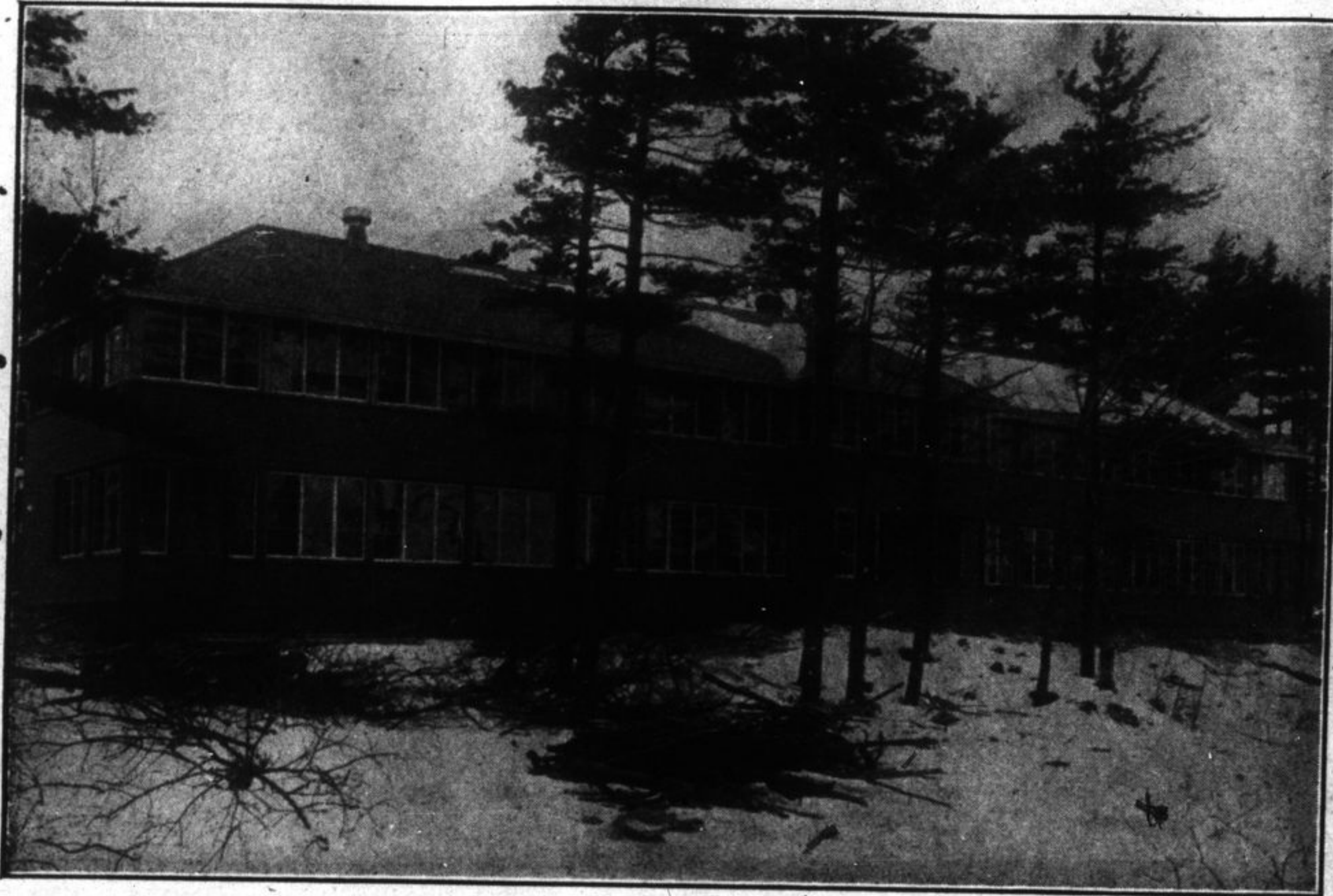
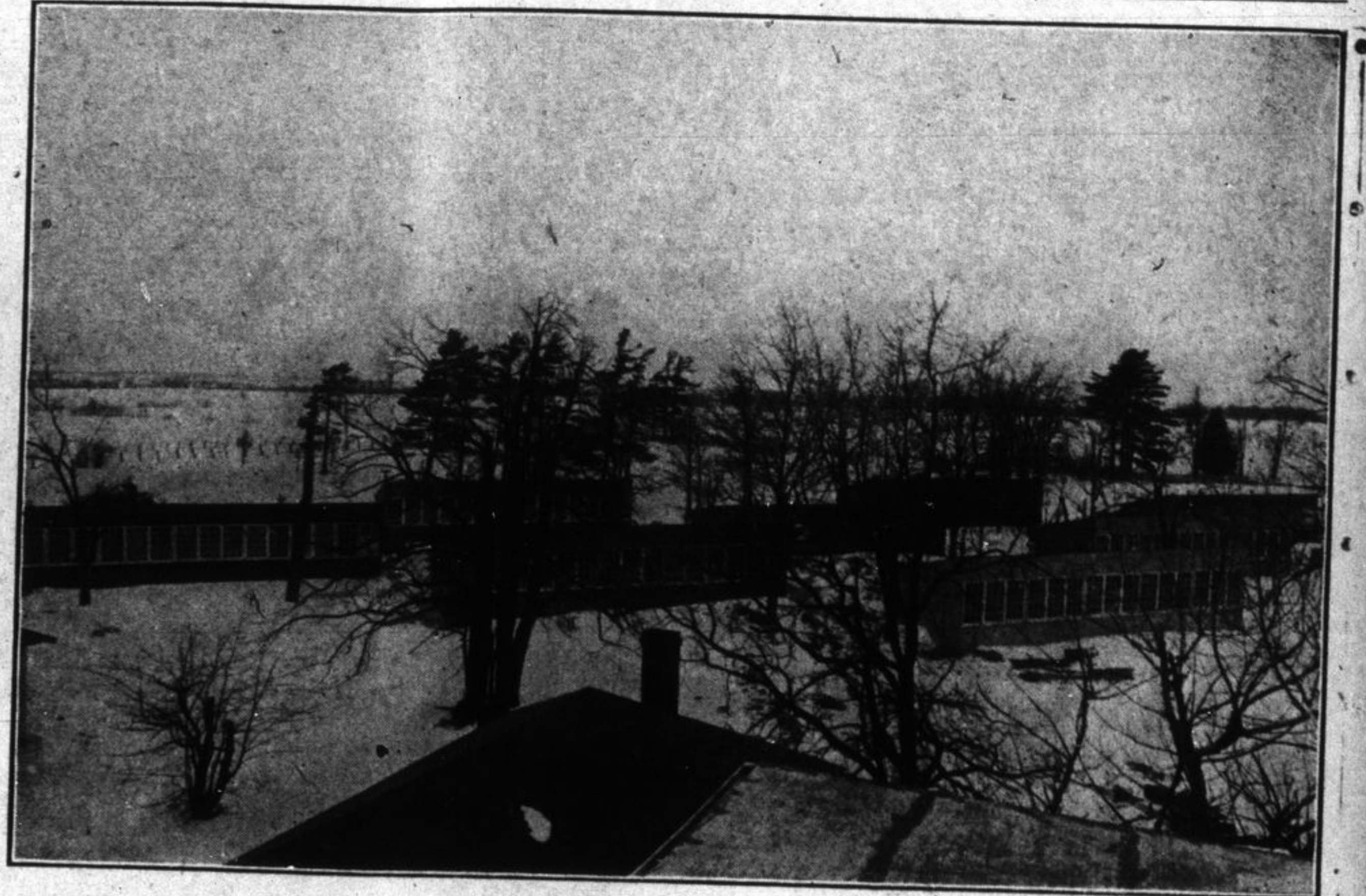

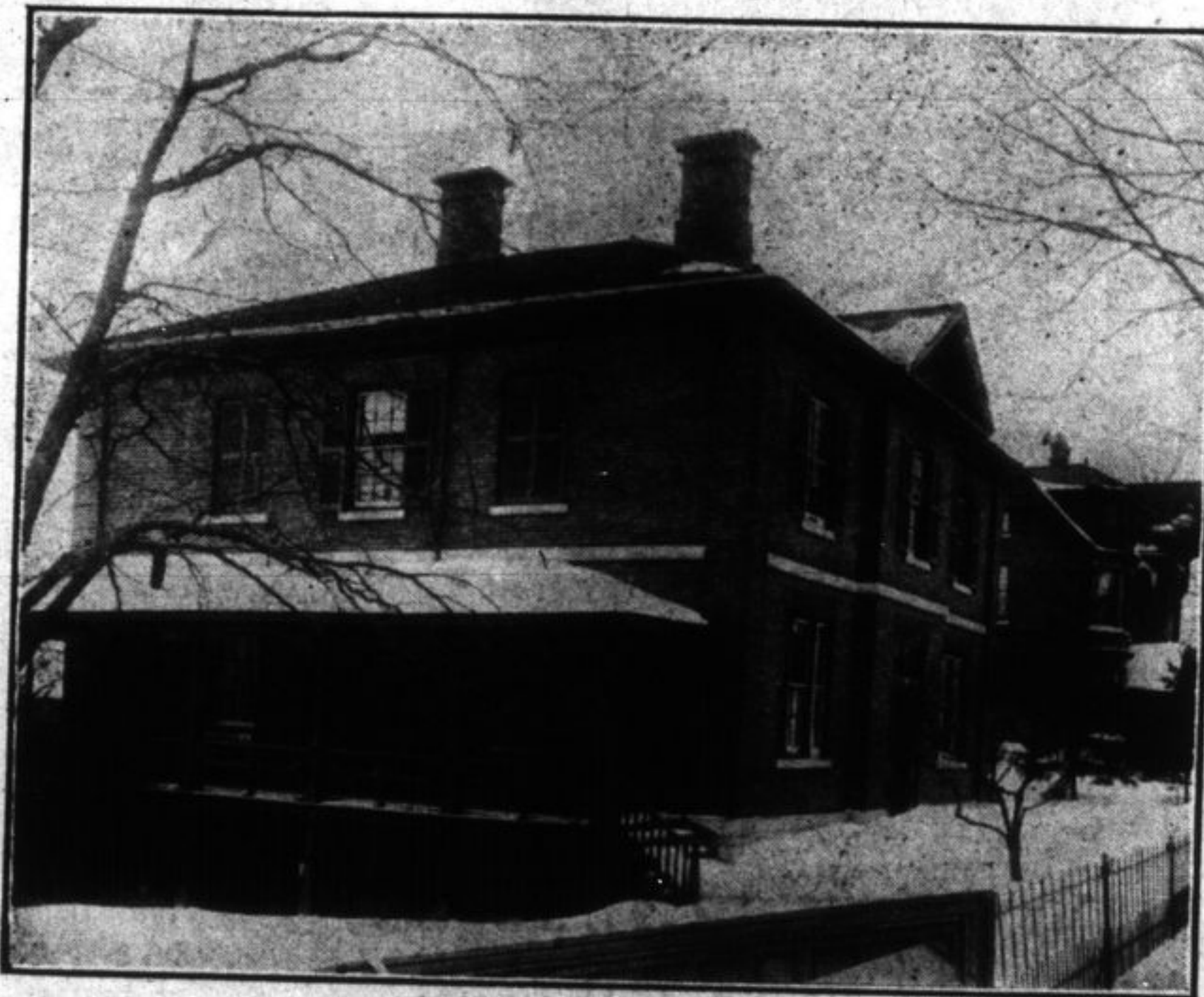
One of the big pavilions erected for the caring of the returned soldiers at the Mowat Memorial Hospital.



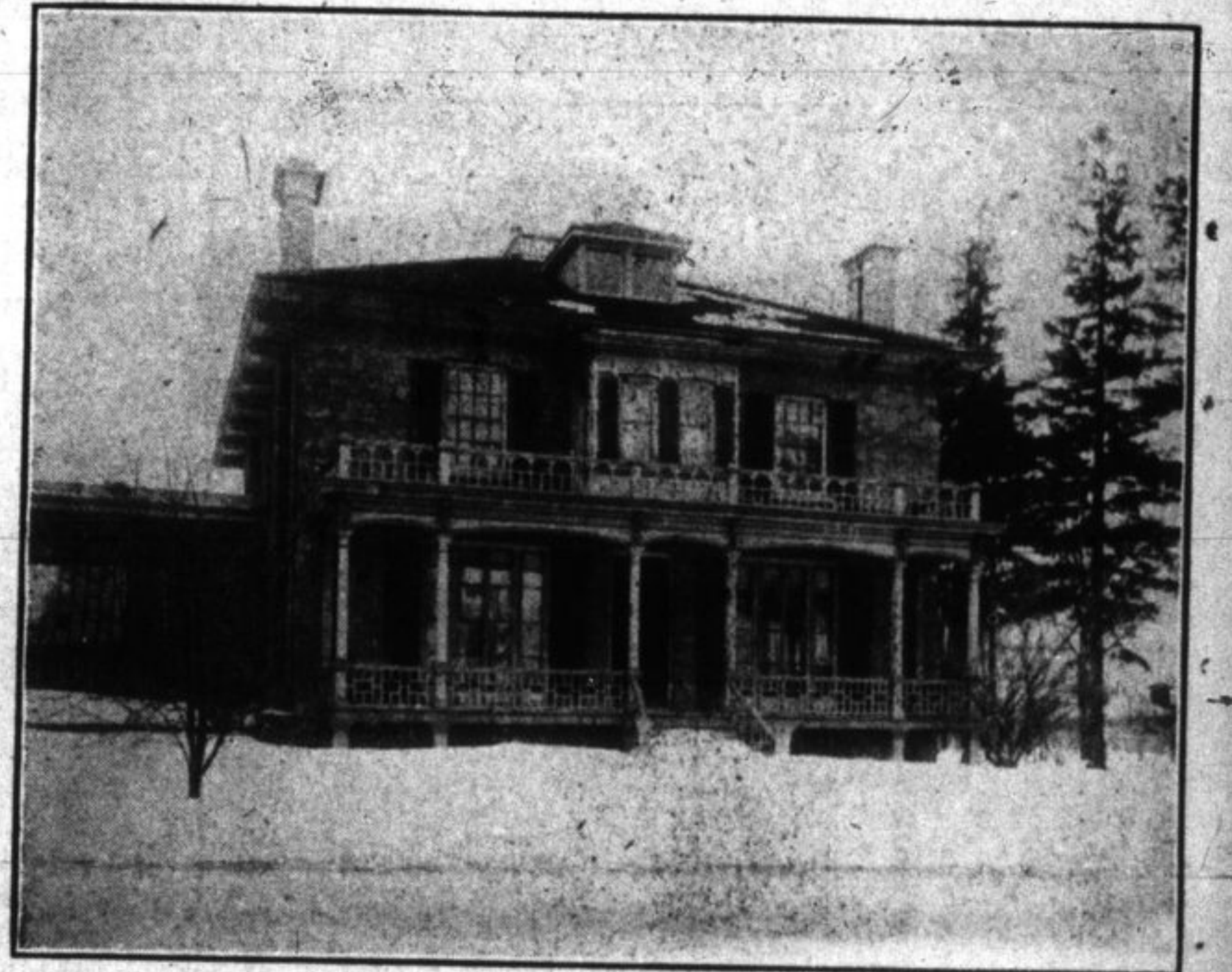
Bird's eye view of shacks erected for the out-door treatment of returned invalided soldiers. Part of the Mowat Memorial Hospital.
