NO LOAFING NOW IN WEST VIRGINIA

Law Makes All Men Work Thirty-six Hours a Week.

Charleston, W. Va., June 22.—Everybody worked in West Virginia today. Each consumer was a producer as well—or a law violator.

Under a state law effective today every able-bodied man in this state between the ages of 16 and 60 must engage in some recognized occupation, profession or employment and contribute to the support of himself and his dependents.

Unless these men work 36 hours a week, they are liable to a fine of \$100 and hard labor on the streets for sixty days.

Rich and poor alike are affected. Clipping coupons isn't listed among the legitimate occupations. The law was passed at the suggestion of the state defense council and with the sanction of the National Council as a war measure.
