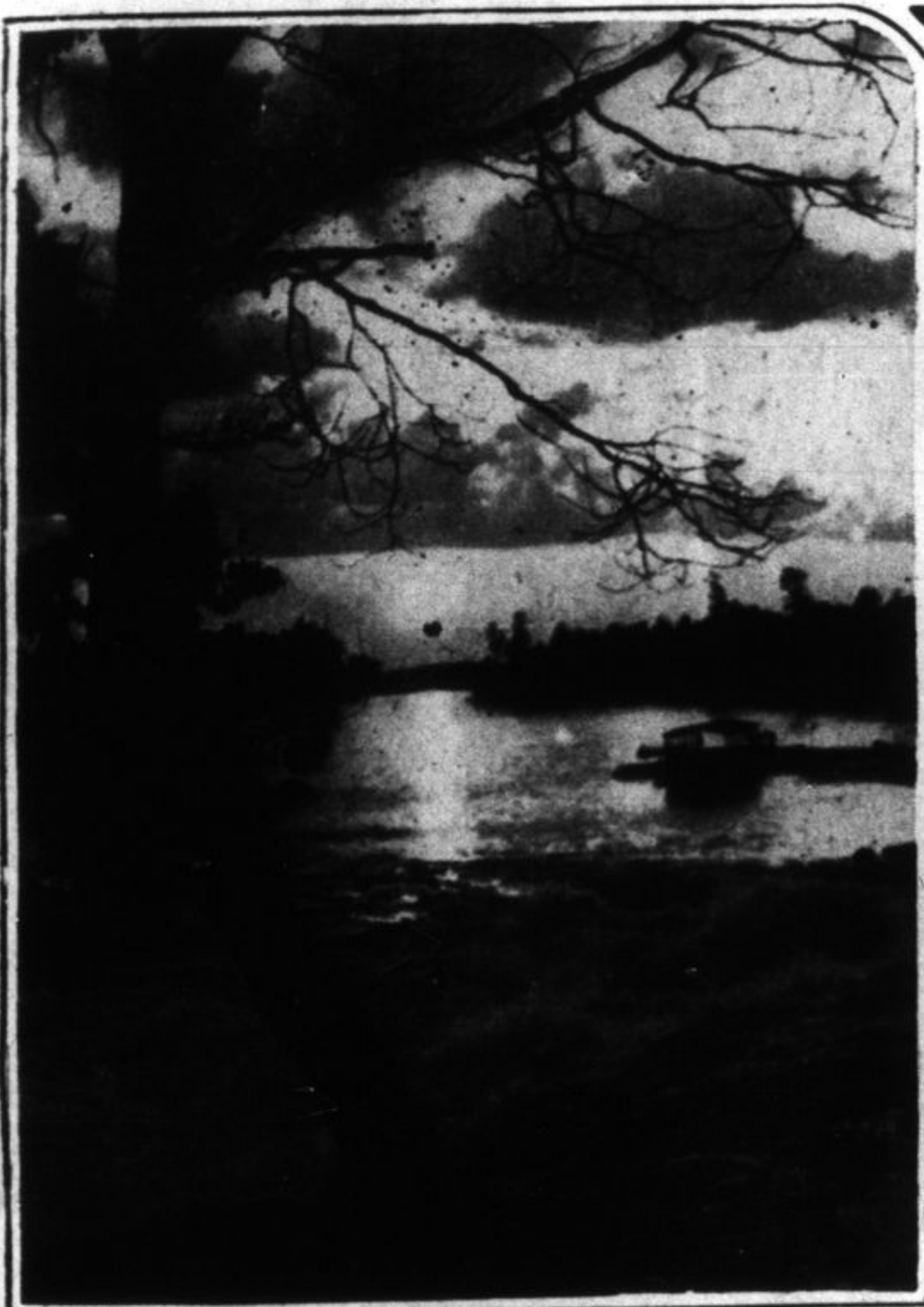


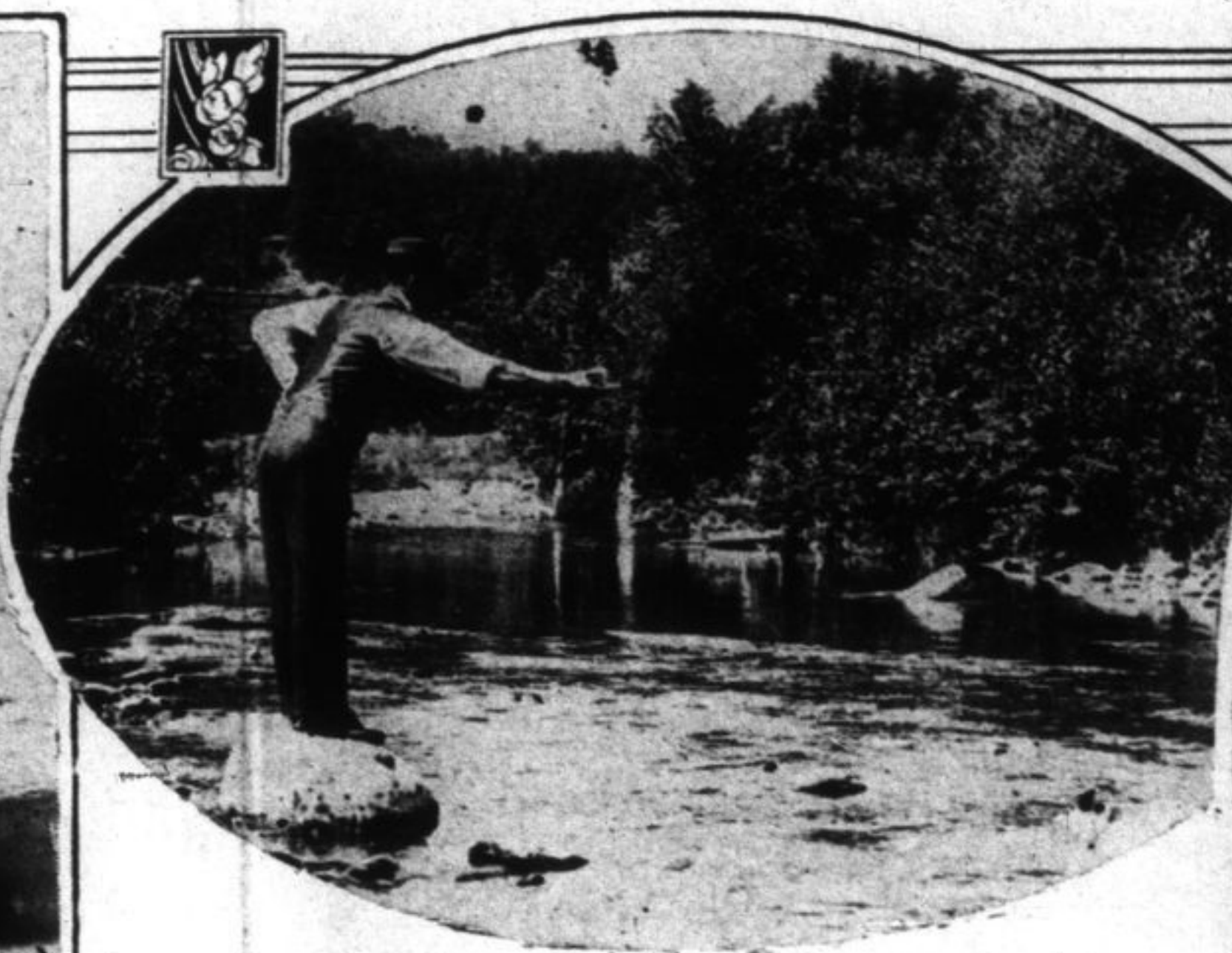
ONTARIO SCENES WHICH TELL US THAT HOLIDAY TIME IS HERE AGAIN



Sunset on the Moon River, Muskoka.



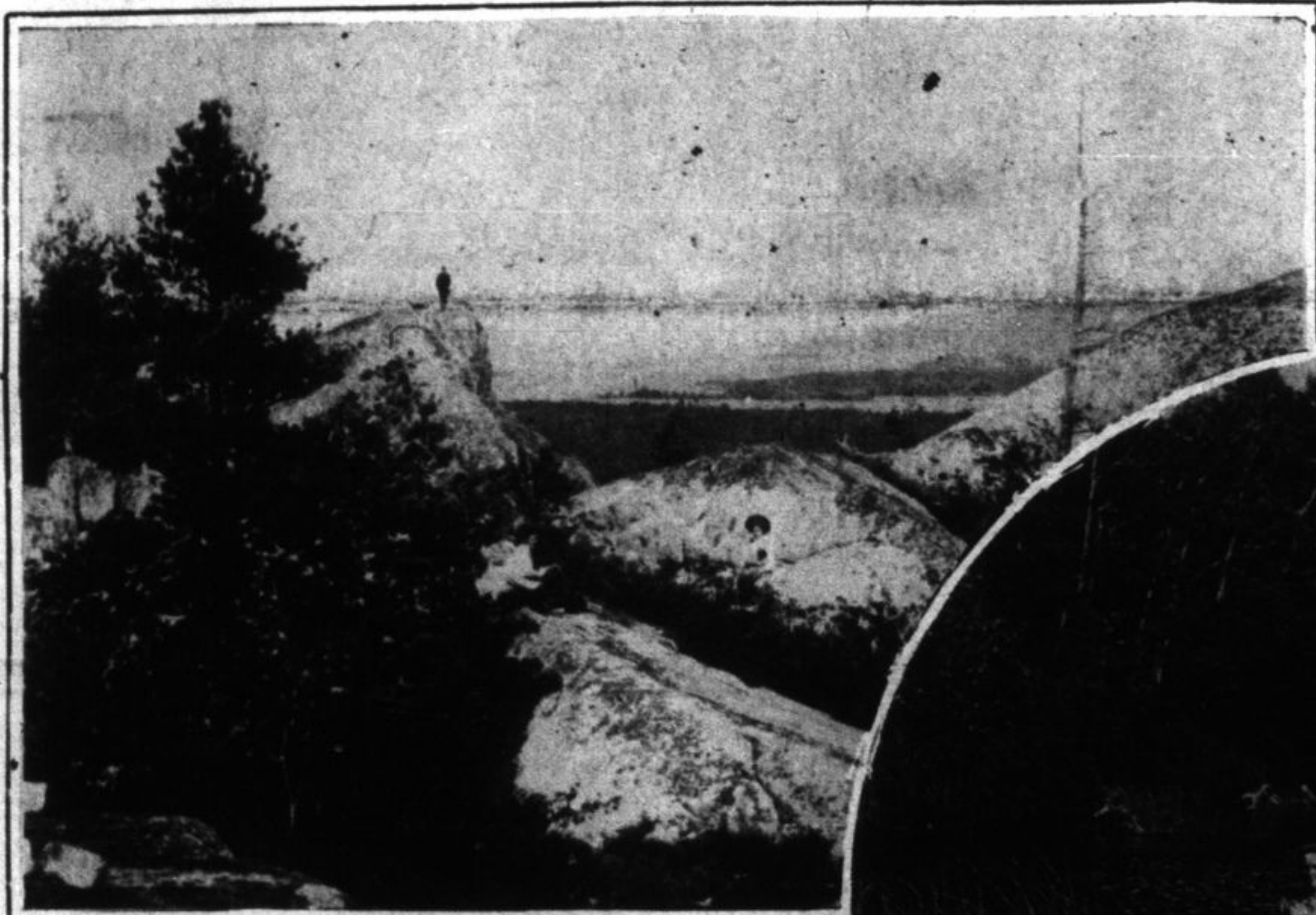
Riding the plank behind a fast motor boat in Muskoka. It is real sport and the chances are against you staying on.
