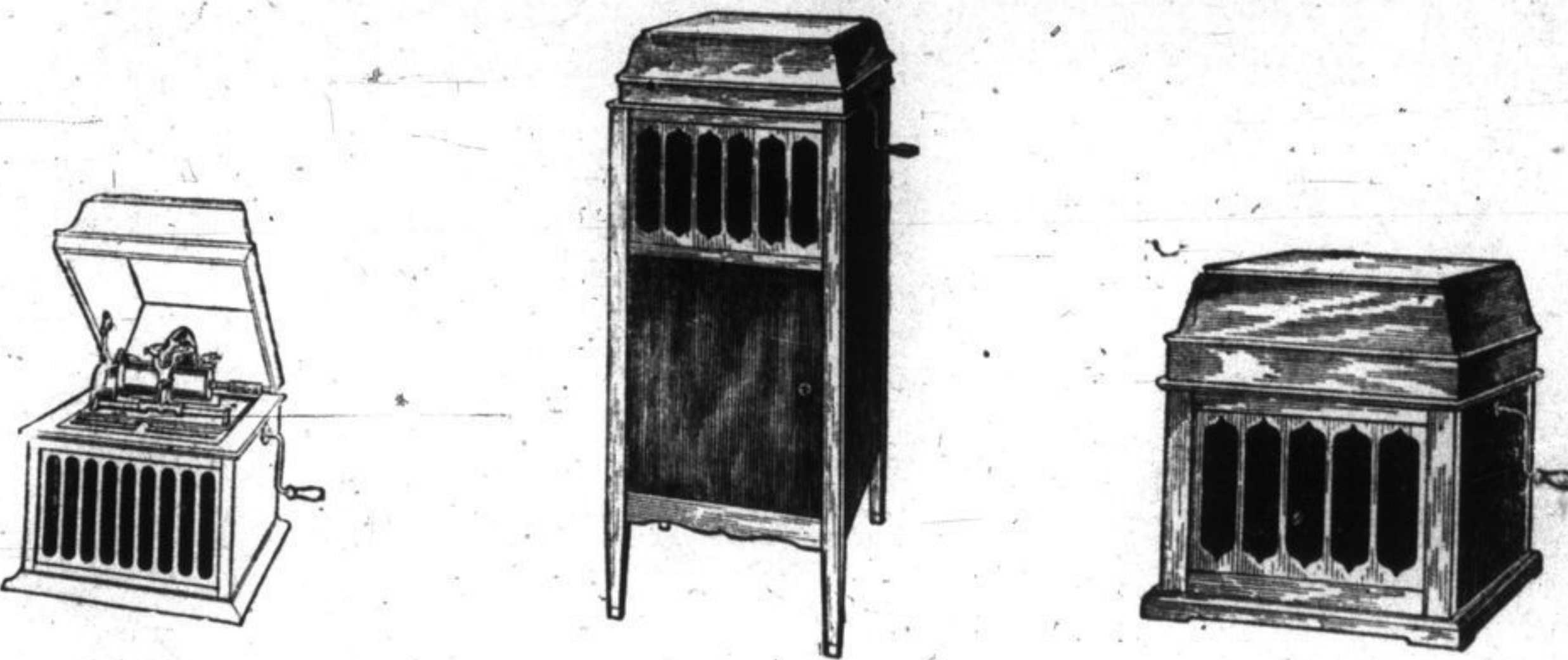
BATTLE OF ARRAS IS DESCRIBED. By Major Brown Mackie, Son of Rev. Dr. John Mackie.
