



Scenes Along the Route of The Canada Steamship Lines--Niagara-to-the-Sea




A picturesque view of Quebec, the foundation stone of the new world.



Montmorency Falls, more than a hundred feet higher than Niagara.




A bird's-eye view of Montreal as seen from Mount Royal.




Fishing among the Thousand Islands is rare sport. These anglers will have a real "Fish Story" to tell.
