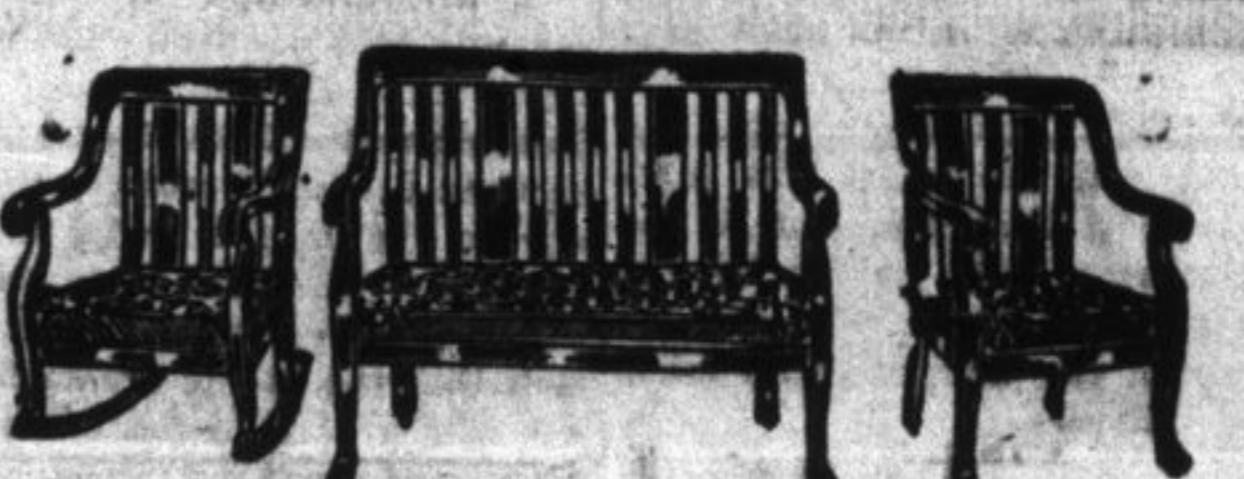

Obituary Fathers Leaving Mattawa.

Pembroke, Aug. 27.—His Lordship Bishop Ryan announced several obituaries in Pembroke diocese. The Obituary Fathers are leaving Mattawa, where they have labored for many years, and are transferring to the diocese of Hullbury. Rev. J. N. Smith's Falls to Link with Hydro

Two By-Laws for Power Carried and Third for Bonus Defeated by 60 Votes. Smith's Falls, Aug. 27.—Three by-laws were voted on by the citizens here on Wednesday. One was to raise \$135,000 to purchase from the Smith's Falls Electric Power Commission their electric plants, etc. Another was to purchase a supply of power from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario. The third was to raise by debentures the sum of \$67,000 as a grant to the Exclusive Ladies' Whitewater, Limited, of Montreal to establish in Smith's Falls a factory for the manufacture of ladies' wear. There has been a good deal of hard work by the promoters on the different sides of the question. The by-laws to bring in the power and to buy the plants were carried by good majority and that to bonus the whitewater company was defeated on a two-third vote by about 60 votes.
