Seeing opportunity for adventure, Ravenslee agrees not to turn "Spike" over to the police, and accompanies the young tough home to Mulligan's Flats on Tenth Avenue. Here he meets many people; among them Spike's half-sister, Hermione, needle-expert and good angel of the neighborhood; Bud McGinnis, the evil companion of Spike, Who would have Hermione for his girl; Mrs. Ann Angelina Trapes, the widow who takes Geoffrey to board, and Spider Connolly, good-hearted prize-fighter. Adventure on adventure follows; the tale is written in high spirits, and Farnol is as thoroughly at home when describing a fist fight at O'Rourke's as he was in his previous books when unfolding a mediaeval contest at arms; while his knowledge of Tenth Avenue character and vernacular, acquired during his lean years as a scene painter in New York studios, is marvelous. The reader will follow with a zest the Quixotic career of Ravenslee through Hell's Kitchen until he wins and makes secure the love of one of Mr. Farnol's most appealing heroines.
