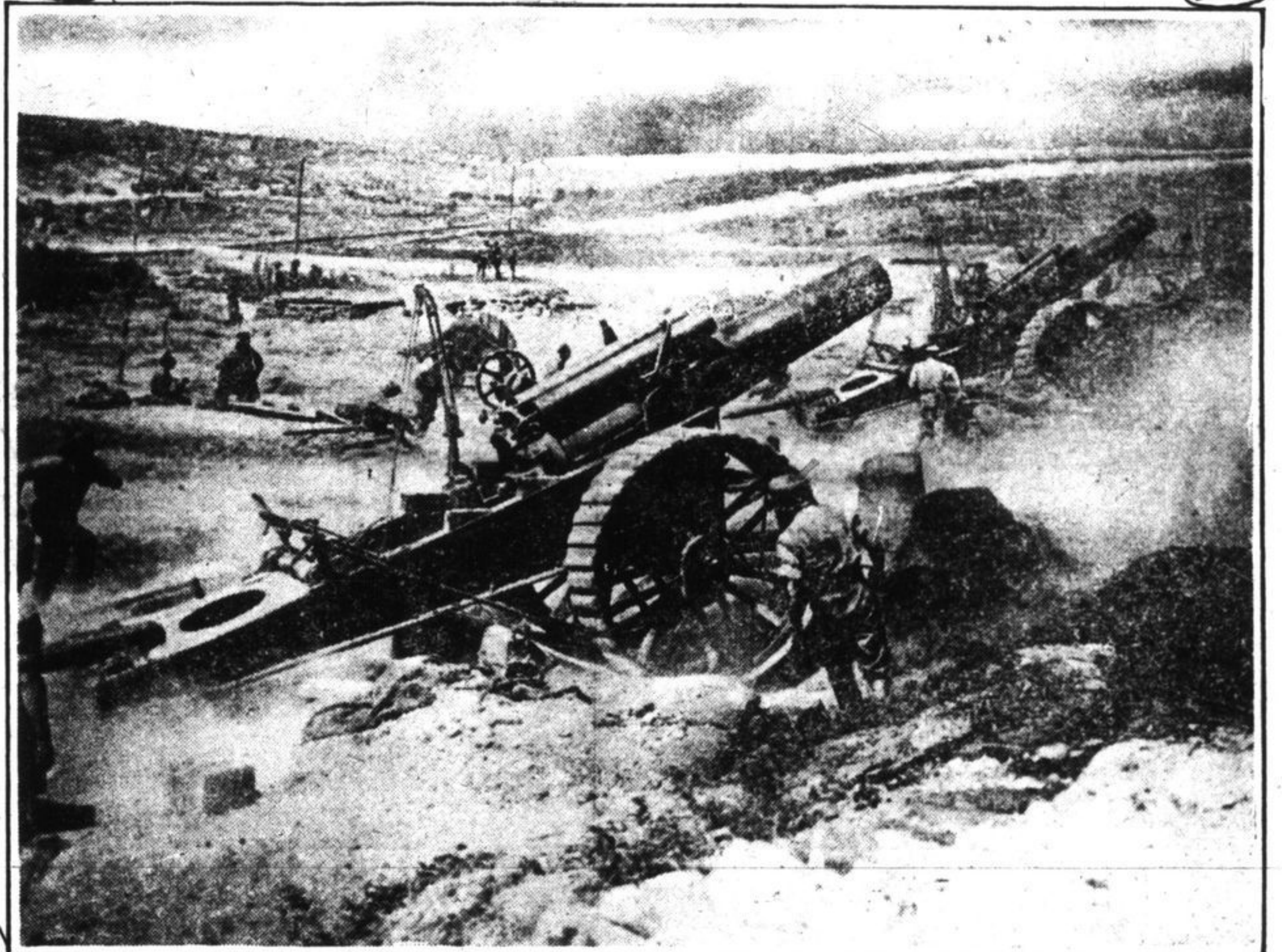


British women belonging to the motor transport service in France, which is now a recognized part of the Army's organization.

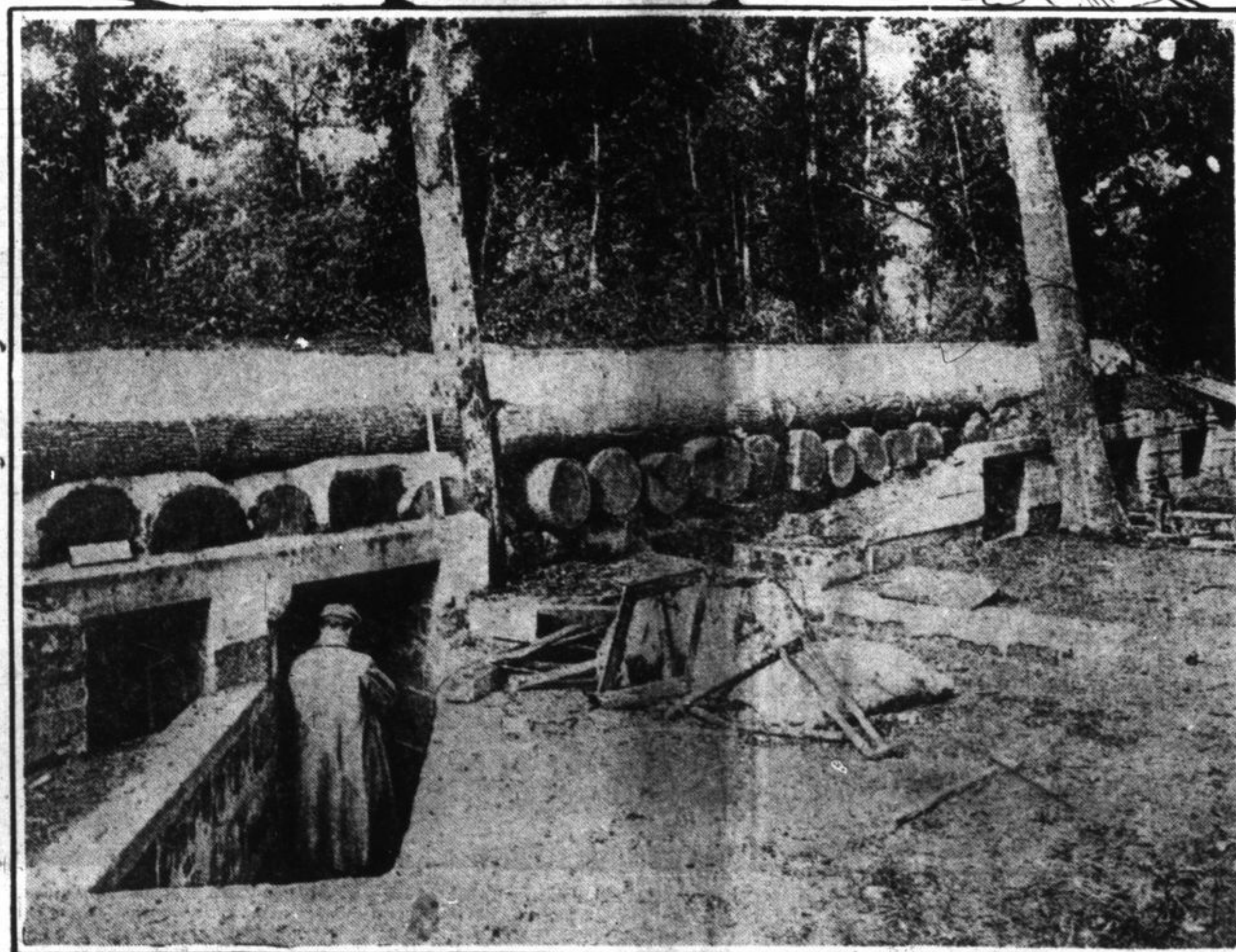


A factor in recent advances. A striking photograph of British howitzers pounding the German Trenches.

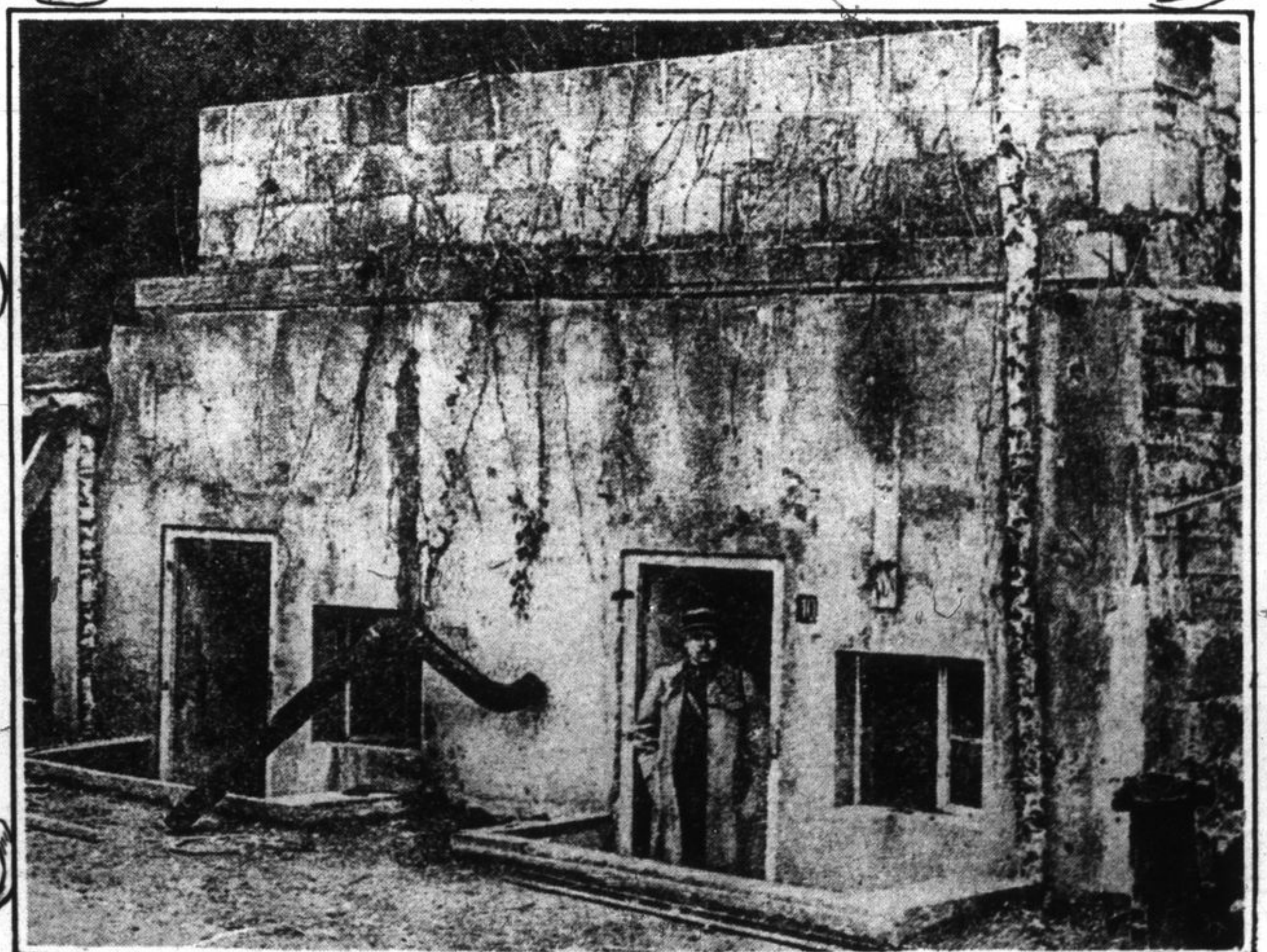


General Cadorna, Italian Commander-in-Chief, whose troops have made such wonderful advances against the Austrians.
