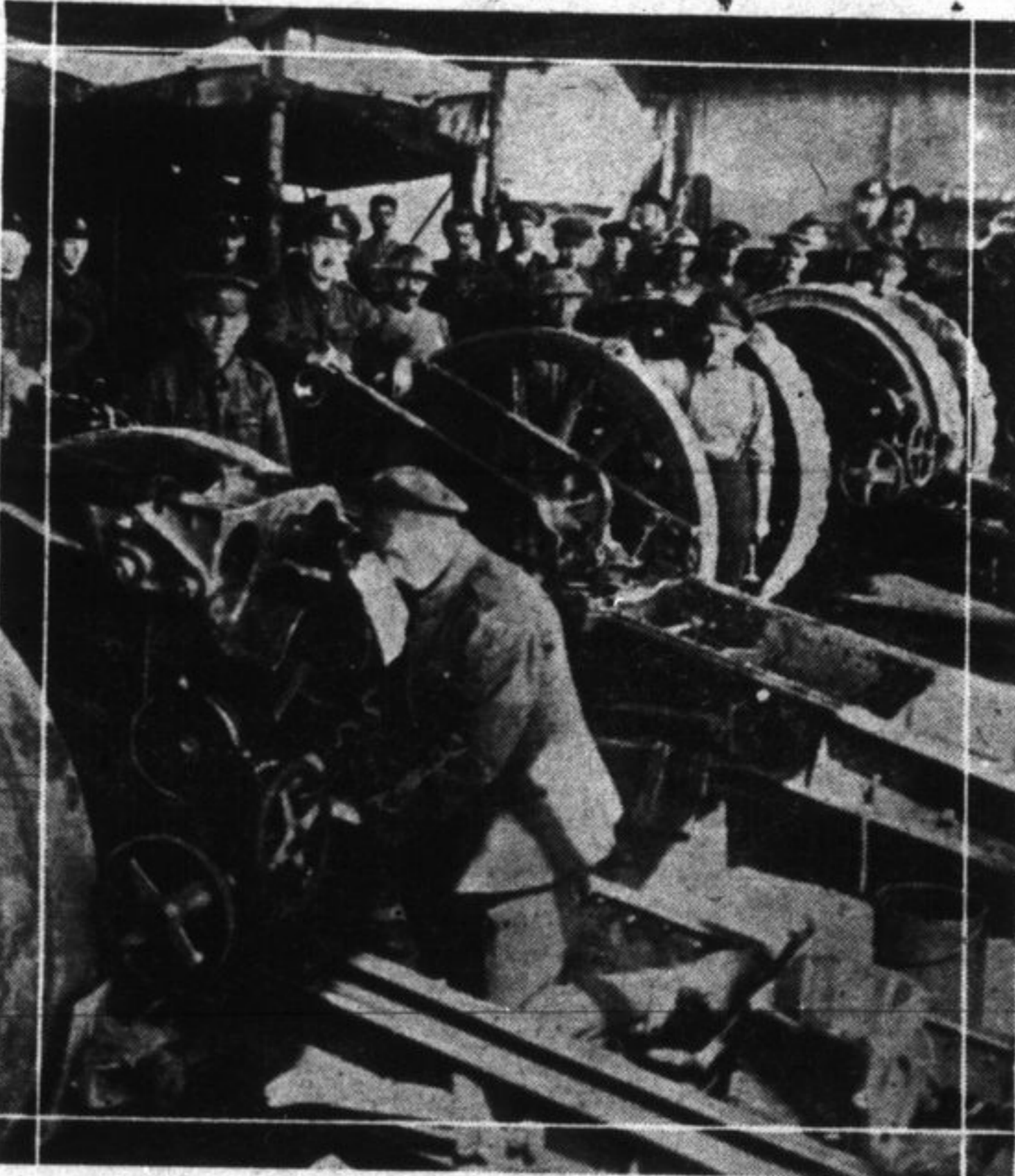

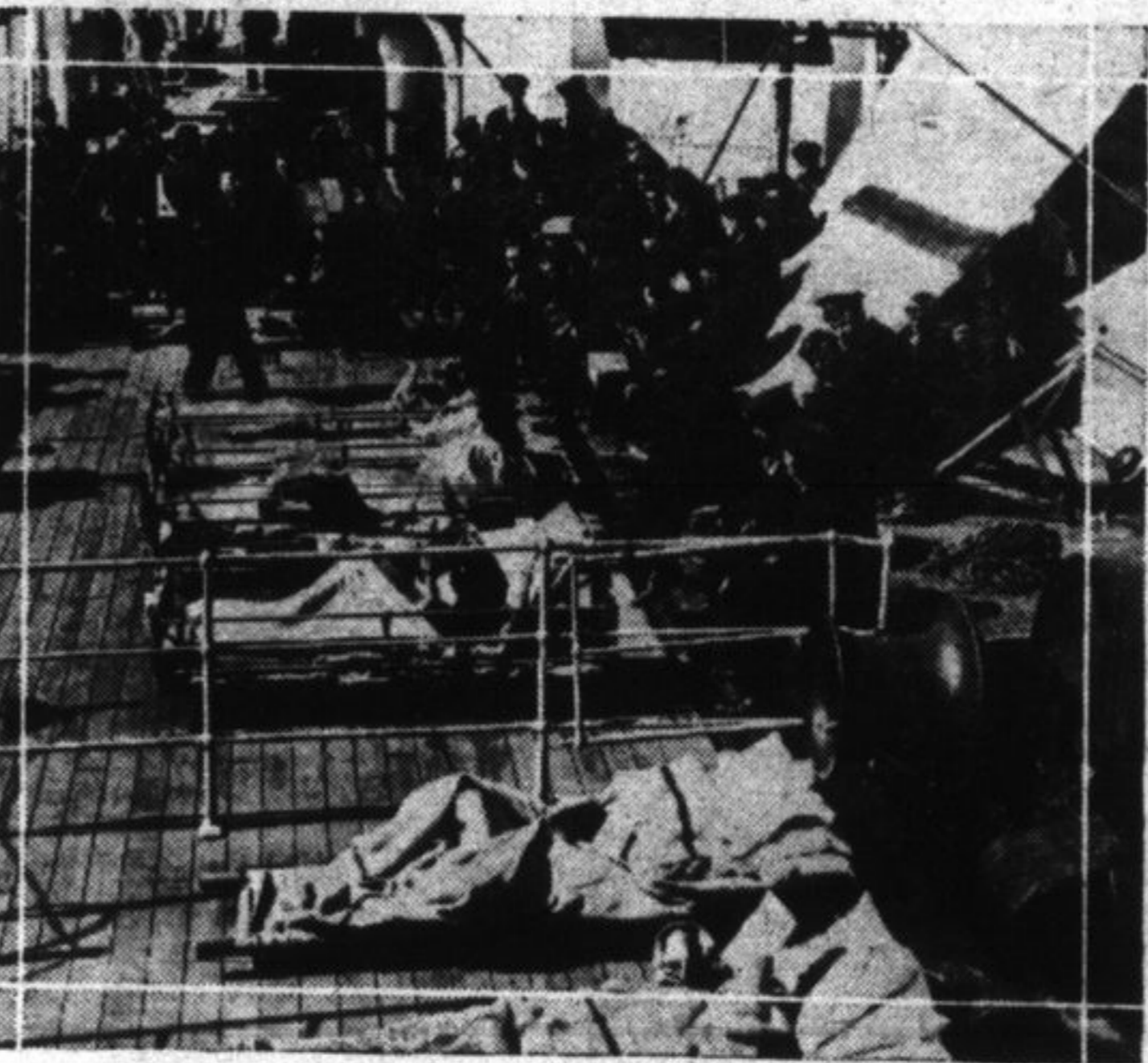

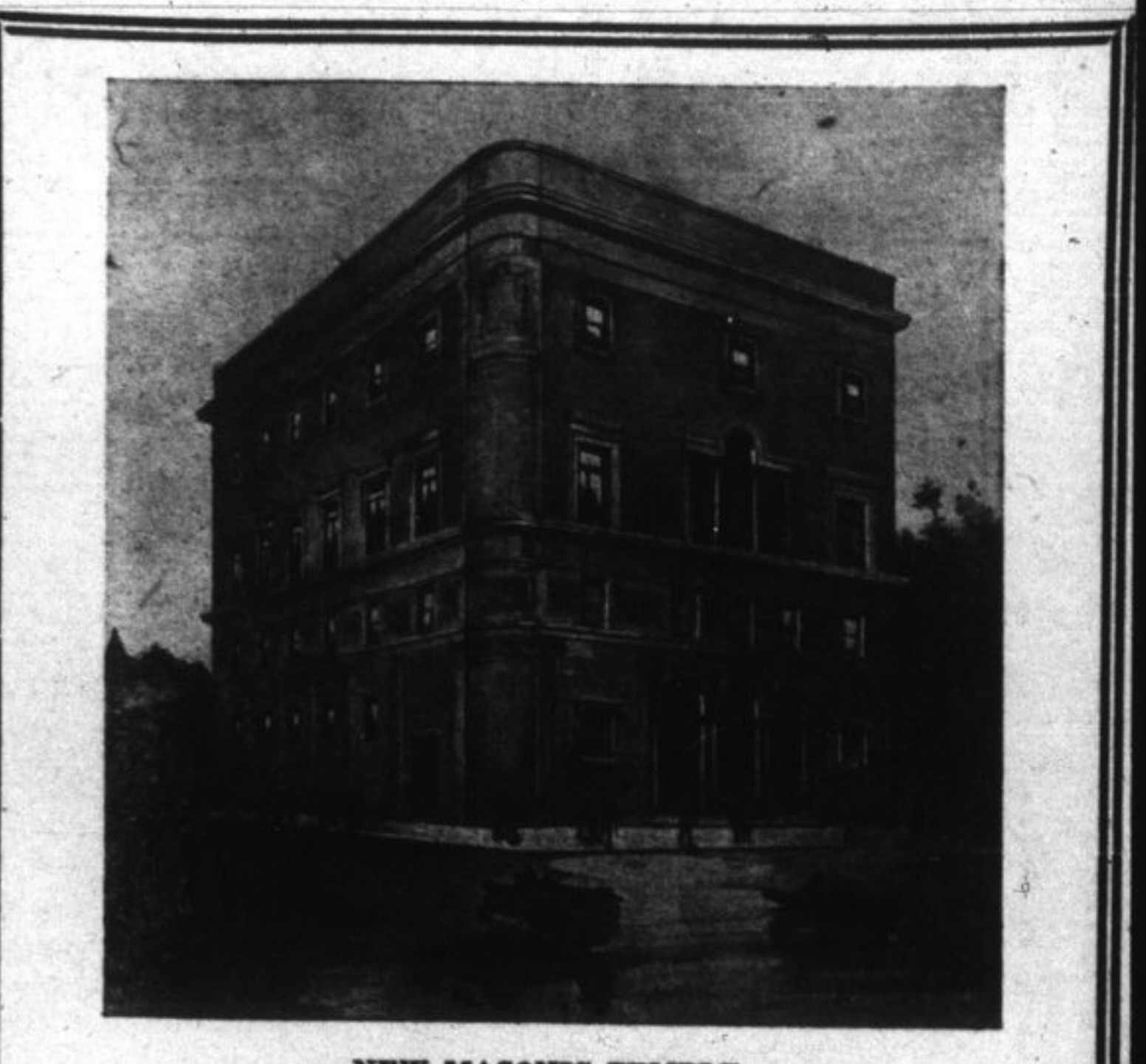


A REMARKABLE COUPLE.
