TURBINA OFF TO COAST

THIS STEAMER WAS IN PORT ON MONDAY MORNING

Will Be Taken For Work on the Coast—The Movements of Other Vessels Reported Around the Harbor.

The steamer Turbina, which has been used in the passenger trade between Toronto and Hamilton for some time, was in port on Monday morning on her way to the coast, where she will be used for special work.

The steamer Hinckley and the steamer Isabella Hinckley cleared for Oswego, after discharging at Richardson's elevator, 50,000 bushels of damaged grain taken off the barge Hamilton, which went aground at Point Peninsula.

M. T. Co's Bulletin: The tug Magnolia arrived from Montreal, with three light barges, and cleared for Montreal, with three grain barges; the steamer Arabian passed up, from Montreal, on her way to Port Colborne; the steamer Oakland discharged grain into river barges and cleared for Port Colborne; the steamer India discharged a grain cargo into river barges, and cleared for Port Colborne; the steamer Jex arrived with coal, from Sodus; the steamer Joyland transhipped grain into river barges and cleared light for Port Colborne; the tug Bronson is due to arrive to-day, with two grain barges; the tug Smith arrived from Montreal with two light barges and cleared with two grain barges for Montreal; the steamers Ionie, Western and Simla, are due to arrive to-day, to discharge grain from Port Colborne.

Canada Steamship Lines: The steamer City of Ottawa passed up from Montreal Monday morning; the steamer City of Hamilton passed down on her way to Montreal; the steamer Hamilton passed down mid-night Saturday, with the barge Eagan in tow, on her way from Erie to Montreal.

POLITICAL NEWS.

F. N. McCrea, late member for Sherbrooke, has accepted re-nomination as a straight Laurier candidate.

S. Marshall, a rancher, was nominated for the riding of Macleod at a Non-partisan League convention at Macleod, Alta.

H. H. Stevens was nominated by the Conservative Unionists of Vancouver Centre.

J. S. Crowe, former city Alderman in Vancouver, is the choice of Liberal Unionists in Burrard Centre.

Liberals in Victoria, B.C., are split since the decision to put a Laurier candidate in the field, and a new organization of Unionist Liberals will be formed at once.

A Unionist convention at Camrose, Alta., chose James R. Holden as Government candidate for Victor, Alta.

While declaring the Military Service Act an "immoral and unjust one," but advising all young men to register in order to preserve their votes, L. A. Lapointe again accepted nomination in St. James' Division Montreal.

Allan T. Mode, a barrister in Edmonton South, is the Laurier candidate in Strathcona, Alta.

A joint convention to select a Unionist candidate for Nanaimo, B. C., has been agreed upon. Liberal, Conservative, Labor and Win-the-war League delegates will take part.

N. T. MacMillan was selected as the Laurier candidate in South Winnipeg.

Liberal and Conservative Executives have agreed on the selection of George M. Byron, a Liberal, as the Union Government candidate in Charlotte, N. B. The last member was T. Herft, a Conservative.

A section of the Conservative party disagrees with the choice, and a convention will be held.

Dr. Edmond Lesage received the Liberal nomination for Hochelaga Division in Montreal.

Lieut.-Col. P. E. Blondin, Postmaster-General, now overseas, has been offered the nomination as the "Win-the-war" candidate in Wright county, Que. Should he not accept, H. Pritchard of Wakefield, Que., was named as alternate candidate.

Maximalists is the name of extremists who want everything and do not stop at any means to accomplish their ends. The name is obviously derived from the word "maximum."
