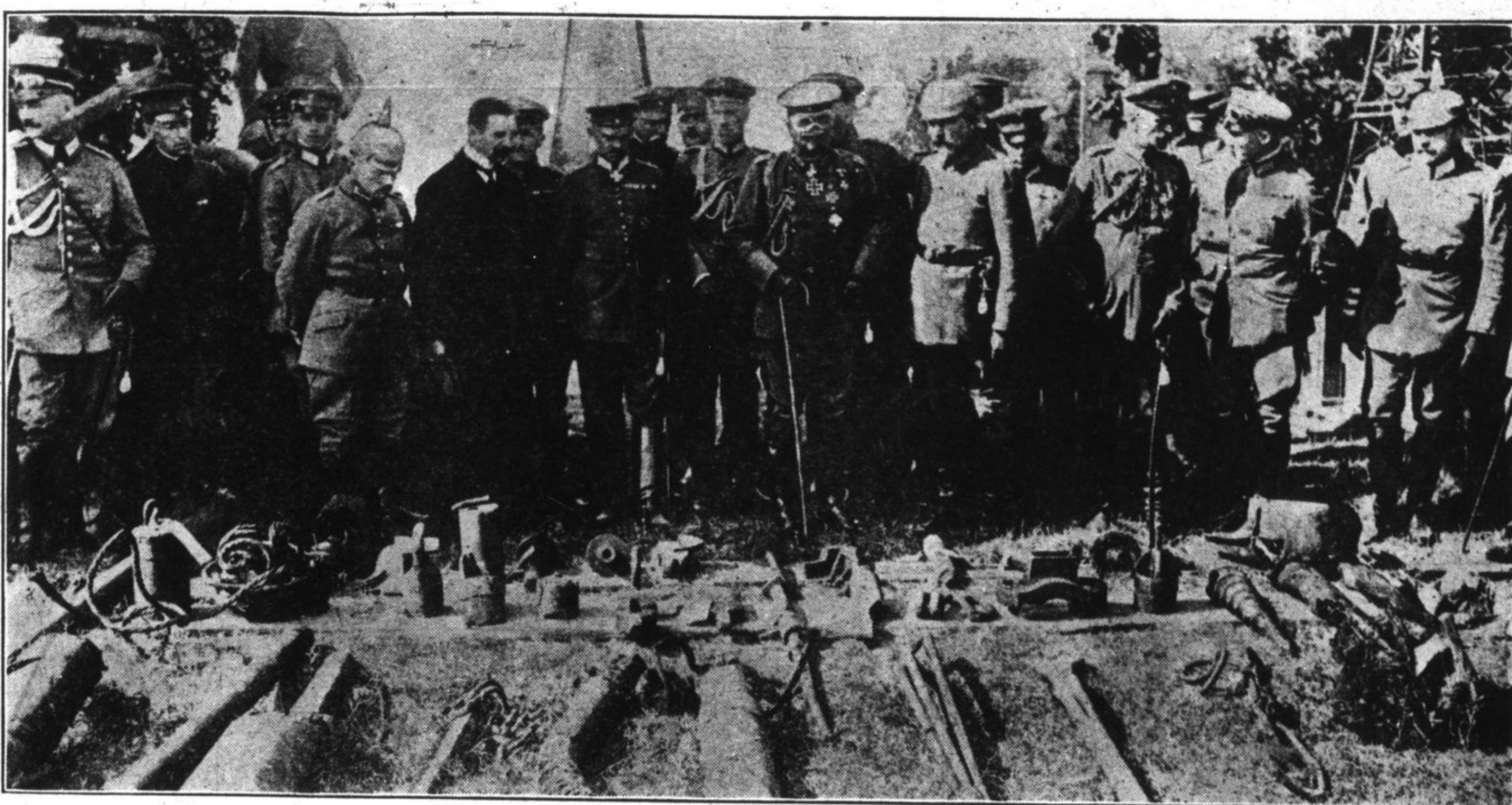

The mourning band of the Kaiser's withered left arm is in marked contrast to the numerous war crosses that are spread over his breast.
