Dress in Gray Jersey.
center-front. Arrange on underbody, center, fronts and center backs even; basic armhole edges together. Lap fronts matching large "O" perforations, close at left side-front.
Close the back seam of the collar and sew to neck and to front edges of outer waist with notches and center-backs even together.
Now, take the sleeve and crease on slot perforations and bring folded edge to small "o" perforations, stitch

Youthful and effective is this costume of gray jersey trimmed with satin in self-color and buttons.
A youthful design, featuring the dart-fitted waist in this dress of gray jersey. The shawl collar is of satin in self-color, the fronts being crossed and buttoned in double-breasted effect. The back of the waist is laid in plaits at the lower edge and lengthened by a straight band, gathered at the sides to form a girlye. Deep cuffs. Finish the one-piece sleeves. In medium size the costume requires 3 1/2 yards 54-inch material.
The underbody may be omitted, if desired, but if used is very simple to make. To properly start the outer waist, take up a dart in front at shoulder, bringing together and stitching along corresponding lines of small "o" perforations. Plait front, also lower edge of back placing "T" on corresponding small "o" perforations and tack. Gather band between "T" perforations, sew to lower edge of outer back as notched. Close under-arm and shoulder seams as notched. Large "O" perforations indicate
