

OUR LADY CONDUCTORS

GREATLY IMPRESSED A REPORTER FROM OTTAWA.

Tells Story About One Putting Unruly Passenger Under Control—No Shortage of Male Help at the Capital.

A representative of the Ottawa Citizen, who spent a few days in Kingston last week, was evidently greatly impressed with the work of the women street car conductors in the city.

Women street car conductors in Kingston are giving entire satisfaction. A Citizen reporter, from enquiries made in the Limestone City during the last few days, has learned that Kingstonians after a three months' trial of the women conductors, are very agreeable to them remaining.

The Kingston Street Railway Company employs six women as conductors, but retain men as motormen. The women sometimes ride in the front vestibule of the car and learn all they can about the manipulation of the brakes, motor, etc., but have not yet been given full control of the driving of the car.

The conductors wear a long blue great coat, with a hat to match, and the uniform looks not unlike that worn by a nursing sister. There seems to be no difficulty in women handling the passengers and the story is told of one buxom lassie putting a drunk under complete control.

Kingston was the first city in Ontario to have women conductors on the street cars. The innovation is one of the many changes which war conditions have brought about. It is expected that other cities will follow suit.

Acting superintendent G. W. Lang, of the Ottawa Electric Railway, was asked this morning by the Citizen if his company had any intention of appointing lady street-car conductors.

ST. LAWRENCE IS FROZEN

ICE STRONG ENOUGH TO BEAR ANY WEIGHT.

Big Loads Being Carried—St. Lawrence Was Frozen Jan. 12th Year Ago.

Ice of a thickness unprecedented for this time of the winter covers the St. Lawrence, is reported at Clayton, N.Y. The ice varies in thickness but is strong enough to bear almost any weight.

For the first time in years the river was frozen over as early as Dec. 12th. Last year the ice in the river did not form until Jan. 12th, just a month later. Old residents say that the river had never frozen over so early, within their memory.

A load of oats weighing 4,700 pounds, was drawn on Wednesday from Grindstone Island. Another example of the strength of the ice was had when a 50-foot boat, equipped with power engines and all paraphernalia, was drawn on sleighs to Thousand Island Park.

T. H. Nunn, a resident of Pine View, has driven over the ice from that village to Clayton with a horse and sleigh. Mr. Nunn experienced no trouble and reported ice of at least eighteen inches all along the river.

Status of Medical, Dental and Veterinary Students is Defined.

The status of medical, dental and veterinary students under the Military Service Act, when such students are in the final year of their studies, has been definitely decided.
