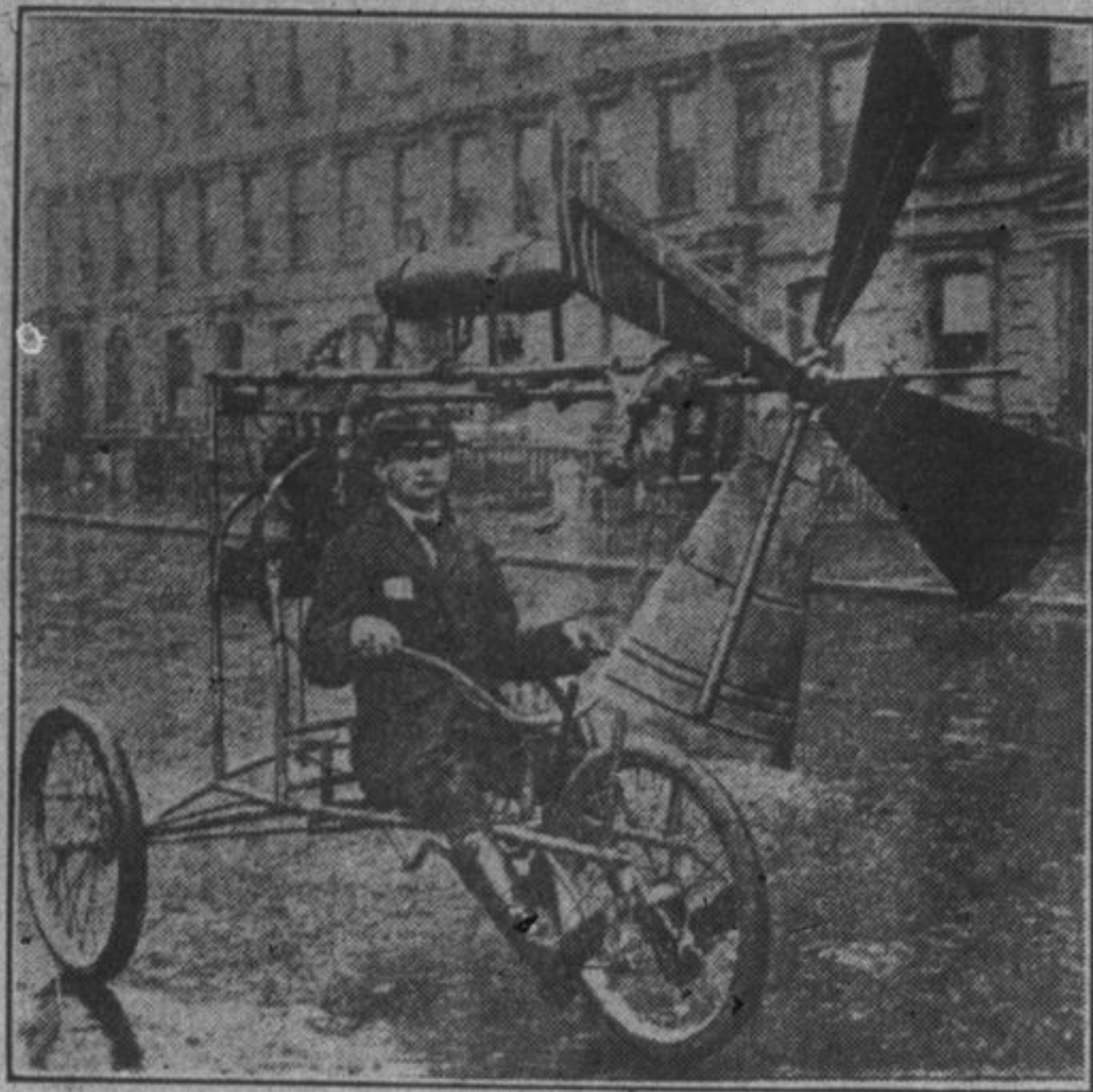
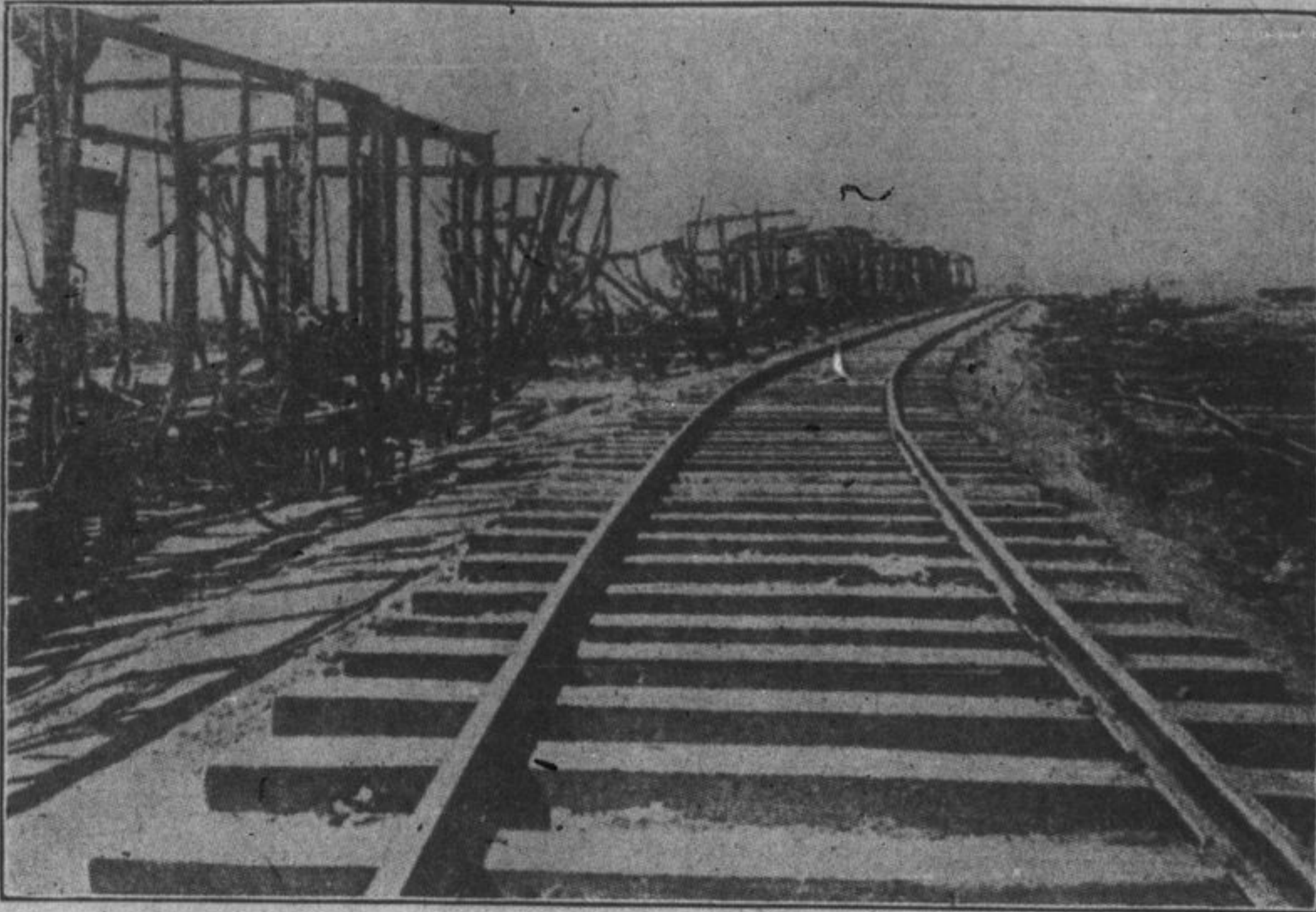


# Striking War Pictures - Russia Holds Promise of Development when Peace Returns



New type of air-driven motor cycle, now seen on the streets of London.



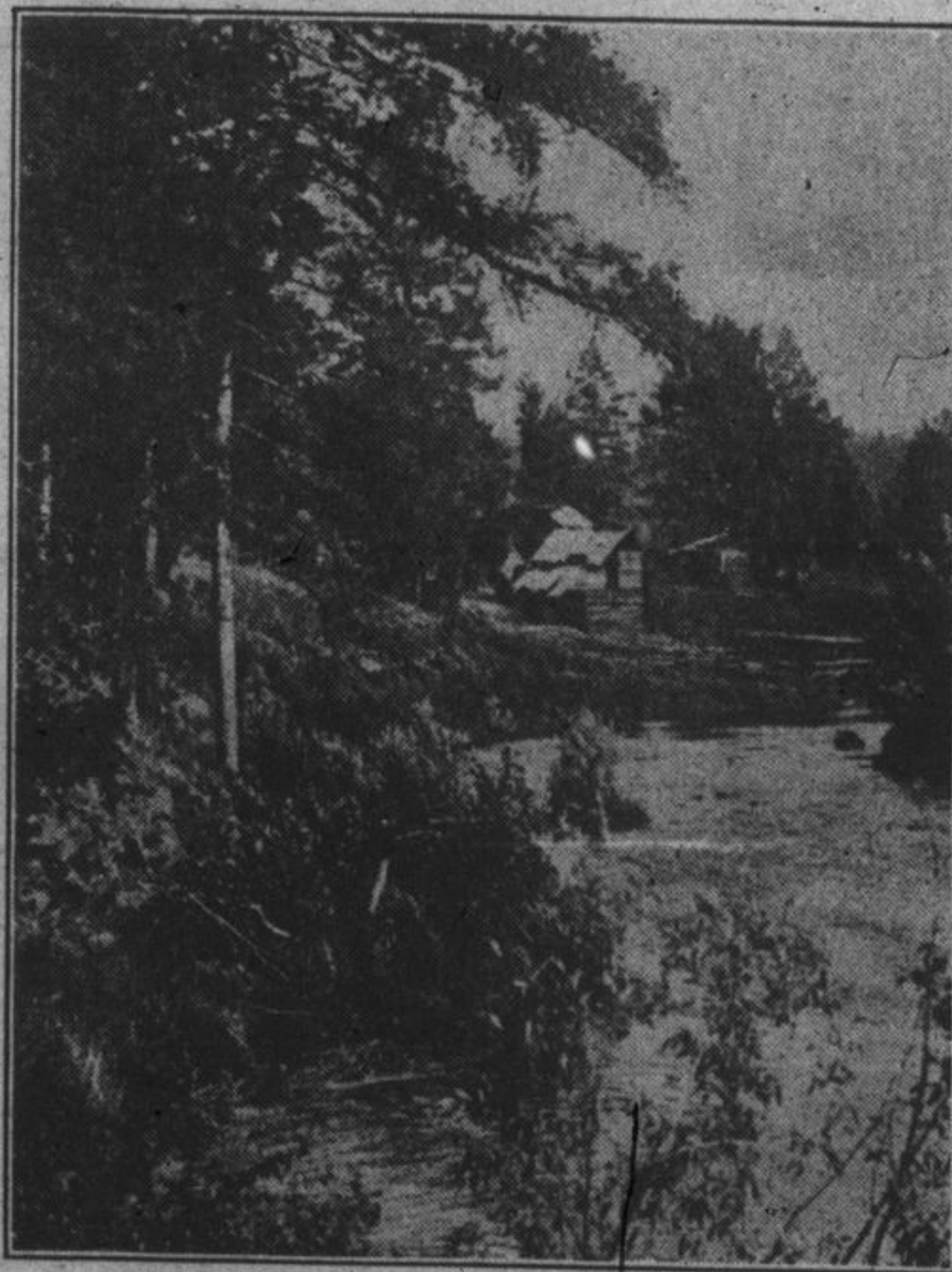
All that is left of a German munitions train bombed by Allied airmen back of Laon. This interesting photograph was found on a Hun captured in the recent drive.
