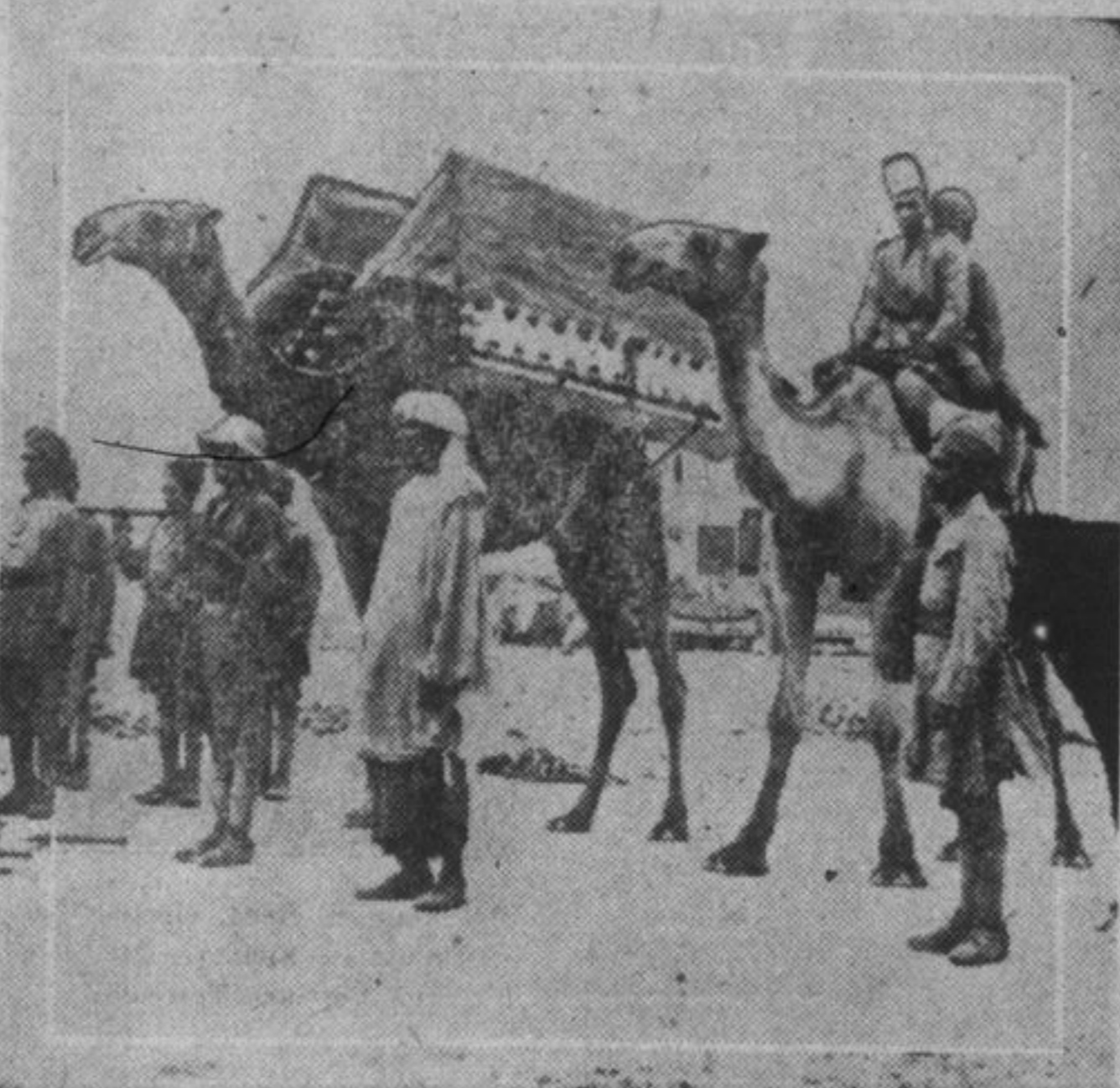


AFTER BAGGING FORTY-TWO FIVE AIRMEN.

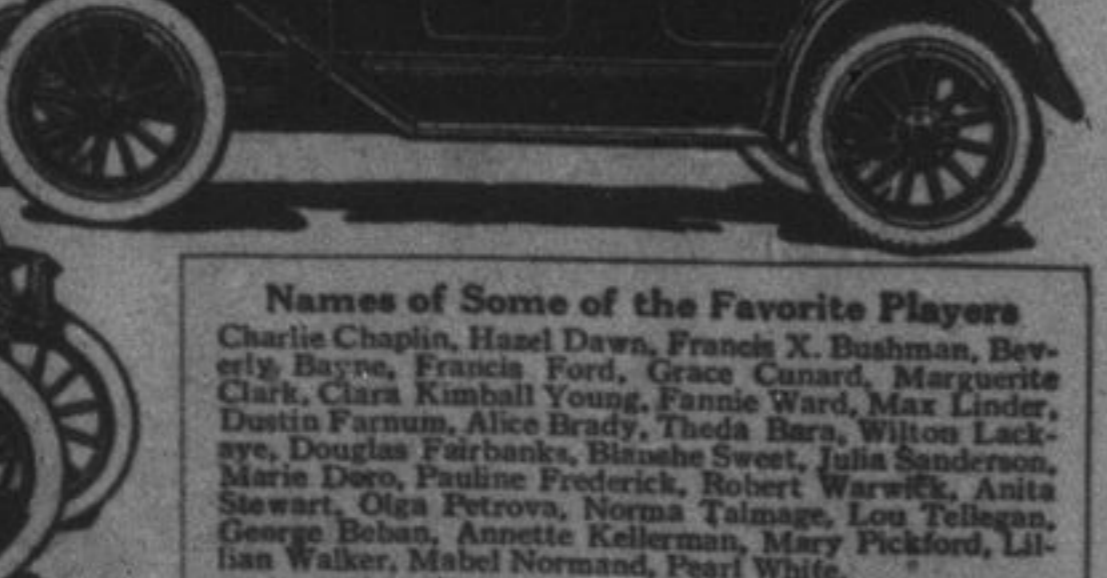

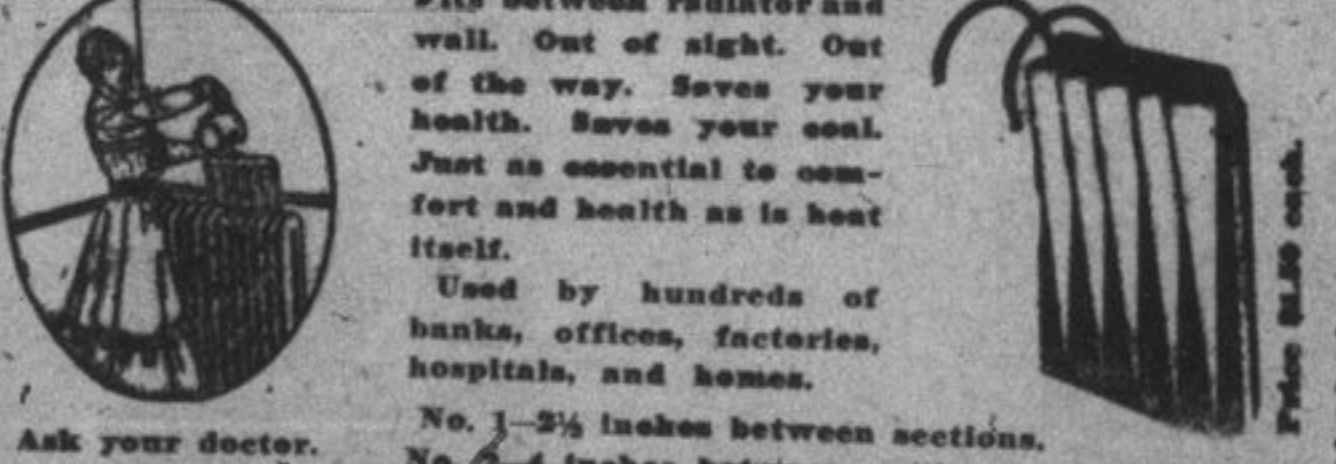

The Board of Education Has the Matter Under Consideration. A CONFERENCE WAS HELD WITH MAYOR HUGHES AND FUEL CONTROLLER NICKLE.

Coal Is On the Way, But the Stormy Weather Has Delayed Its Arrival—Mayor Hughes Orders Twenty-five Cars.

Mayor Hughes and Fuel Controller Hugh Nickle had a conference with the members of the Board of Education, at a special session of the board held Saturday afternoon, when the closing of the schools in order to help out the fuel shortage, was under discussion.

After the situation in Kingston as regards coal supply, had been explained by Mayor Hughes and Mr. Nickle, the board decided, on motion of Trustee Robert Meek, to defer action until the regular meeting of the Board on Thursday evening next, and in the meantime the Property committee, which has to deal with the coal supply for the schools, will meet with the mayor and the fuel controller with regard to the matter, and report at the meeting of the Board Thursday next.
