LIVING COST IS CHEAPER HERE THAN ELSEWHERE

Comparisons Show That Food Prices Are Lower in Canada Than in Any Other Country at War Including the United States.

Ottawa, Feb. 23.—Canadians grumble at the high cost of living, but official figures at Ottawa show that living is cheaper in Canada today than in any other country at war.

The following is a comparative table of prices in Canada and the United States:

*As the standard quart in use in the United States is only 6-6 of the Canadian quart, the price here given is for the equivalent of the Canadian quart.

Most Commodities Cheaper Here.

In a recent report of the United States Food Administration it is shown that prices are higher in the United States, than in Canada on fourteen commodities (viz. bread, flour, oatmeal, rice, potatoes, beans, fish, tea, pork chops, round steak, lard, milk, butter and cheese).

Fourteen commodities (viz. bread, flour, oatmeal, rice, potatoes, beans, fish, tea, pork chops, round steak, lard, milk, butter and cheese), while on seven commodities prices are lower in the United States (viz. on canned tomatoes, canned corn, canned salmon, canned peas, sugar, coffee, and eggs).
