Lighting is of three kinds—zig-zag, and sharply defined at the edges; it is sheets of light illuminating a whole circle, which seems to open and reveal the light within it; and in the form of fire-balls. The duration of the first two kinds scarcely continues the hundredth part of a second; but the globular lighting moves much more slowly, remaining visible for several seconds. Optical Instruments. A new optical instrument consists of a high-powered incandescence lamp which can be taken into a person's mouth to illuminate his eyes through the retina, enabling them to be examined through the pupils. Musical Conductors. Really great musical conductors are few and of these Hans Richter stood in the forefront. It is difficult to define just what differentiates a good conductor from a mere time beater, but a story that is told of Richter may help indirectly. In the prelude to "Ariana and Isolde" occurs a beautiful passage for the oboe, which rises, swells, and dies away to a pianissimo most effectively. To indicate the quality of the playing which he wanted from this instrument, Richter, beating the time with his right hand, placed his left hand over his heart, and the oboe player, at once responded to a direction all-inclusive in its simplicity and intelligibility.
