In the Black Sea it was the one advantage that made it possible for the Germans to carry on their raids and convoy work. "5. Polishing Diamonds. Before the polishing of a diamond is begun the rough stone must be held firmly. This is accomplished by building a solder mold for it. The mold is first roughly shaped by hand and heated. It is then reshaped as often as necessary to fit the stone erfectly. When it is exactly right, it is heated again and the stone dropped in. Held firmly by the snug solder mold, the stone can then be handled easily.
