GREATER PRODUCTION MOVEMENT

A meeting in the interests of Greater Production, to be attended by all the present members of the General Committee and Special Committees and representatives of various clubs and societies will be held in the Board of Trade rooms on Wednesday evening at 8 o'clock. AN ONTARIO LAND-PROBLEM

An official whose interest in the food production campaign takes him continually into the country districts laments that the number of auction sales of farm property in Ontario is greater than he has observed for years. This condition is especially unfortunate in the midst of a food shortage, as there is often a long interval of time, during which cultivation is at a standstill, between an owner's decision to sell his land and its occupation by a tenant or new proprietor. In many cases it is unavoidable. It is the tragedy of rural Ontario that everywhere ageing couples find themselves alone, and unable to get adequate help, their sons having gone to the war or the cities. There are many men eager to get a permanent footing on the soil, who would gladly take over and work farms of this kind as tenants, or who have a little capital with which they would like to establish themselves as land owners, but there is no machinery to bring them in touch with opportunities in the settled portion of the province.

There is an enormous area of fertile land in the older districts of Ontario, close to the markets, which is either unused or half used. The shortage of farm labor is one factor of the problem, but not the only one. It is a state of things which should seriously concern the Agricultural Department.
