The Mole is a Gormandizer.
The little mole has recently been recommended for membership in the society of big eaters. Frozen Caterpillars Live On.
Interesting experiments have been made by two French scientists, who placed a number of caterpillars in test tubes or metal boxes in a refrigerator, and saturated them with a temperature varying between 15 to 20 degree Centigrade. The same caterpillars were frozen six times in the space of a month, and they always came back to life, but at each new freezing operation their movements and reaction to mechanical excitation became slower.
