**THE WORLD'S NEWS IN BRIEF FORM**  
Tidings From All Over Told in a Pithy and Pointed Way.  
Three days in the week have been set aside in Jamaica when meat is not to be eaten.  
A quantity of butter with finely cut wire mixed in it has been found at Calgary.  
Canada's trade during the year ending with March increased by \$315,292,944, totalling in exports and imports \$2,564,462,215.  
Lack of coal has forced the Austrian Minister of Railways to suspend passenger traffic on the northern roads.  
A party of 67 Laval students, under the command of Lieut. Robert Bourassa, to join the "Tank Battalion" in Ottawa.  
"The time is ripe to extend suffrage to women," Premier Orlando of Italy said, in an interview granted the Giornale d'Italia.  
German provincial towns are greatly disturbed over the enormous casualties resulting from west front offensives. The papers are filled with obituaries.  
Since the outbreak of war 1,500 officers and 22,000 men of other ranks have been brought back to Canada and discharged from the Canadian Expeditionary Force.  
In honor of Melville E. Stone, for twenty-five years general manager of the Associated Press, he was presented, in behalf of the Board of Directors, with twenty-five \$1,000 Liberty Bonds.  
The Ontario Government has completed arrangements for the distribution of fish through a Toronto wholesale firm, and about 8,000,000 pounds have already been ordered for this year.  
Victor Bonin, the French food minister, is considering the declaring of a meatless week each month in order to stop excessive drafts on France's live stock and to check continually rising prices.
