OPENING OF BASEBALL SEASON. Athletics and C.L.C. to Stage Opening on Saturday.

The official opening of the baseball season in Kingston will be on Saturday next. The Athletics and C.L.C. will clash in the grand premiere at the Cricket Field, and in the absence of Mayor Hughes, it is likely that Ald. H. W. Newman and Ald. N. E. O'Connor will officiate in the opening exercises.

Some good baseball material is still in the city, in spite of the enlistment and drafting of some of the best players, and keen competition for the L. T. Best cup is anticipated. The game on Saturday should draw out a large crowd.

Plenty of Gasoline in Sight. A. C. Bedford, president of the Standard Oil Company of New Jersey, and chairman of the petroleum committee of the council of national defence, has said that 35,000,000 barrels of gasoline will be needed this year to meet the requirements of the United States and the Allies. In the first six months of 1917, statistics state there were 24,500,000 barrels of gasoline manufactured in 46 United States. This is at the rate of 5,000,000 barrels a year less than the mark set by the leaders of the industry. The difference will have to be met by a larger refinery output. Mr. Bedford says the refinery capacity of the country is fully able to turn out all the gasoline required.

A Full Radiator. It is important to keep the radiator well filled where a thermo syphon system of cooling is employed. When the water level gets low, the cooling is likely to be faulty. Where alcohol is employed for winter driving, this is particularly true. With the radiator but three-quarters full, the mixture reaches the boiling point quickly and more alcohol evaporates rapidly. This is obviated by keeping the radiator well filled.

Train Negroes As Firemen. St. Thomas, May 16.—Owing to the drastic shortage of firemen on the railroads in St. Thomas caused by the amendment to the Military Service Act, the Pere Marquette Railroad is making negotiations to bring in a large number of southern United States negroes to this city and other divisional points and specially train them for the duties of firemen.
