**They Go Under The Ban.**  
 Winchester, Mass.  
 The editor of the Prescott Journal has got into trouble because he published an article criticising somewhat severely a town official. The article, as we understand it, was simply repeating in the public press what many leading business men of that town expressed privately, or in groups. It so very often happens that an editor in a small town is urged by leading men to take up a question of public complaint and expose it; or to "show up" a wrong or an incapable town official. But when the article is published and a "hornet's nest" of opposition is stirred up, where does the editor generally find himself? To the men who urged the exposure or criticism come forward and stand at the back of the editor? Not very often. They privately tell him he has done the right thing, but they publicly leave him alone to face the music. The Press has on several occasions been asked to take up questions of local interest and "expose" certain transactions and certain persons. But when the party making the request has been asked if he will become sponsor for such an article, or sign his name to it, it becomes another question. This is the lesson the Prescott Journal has learned.
