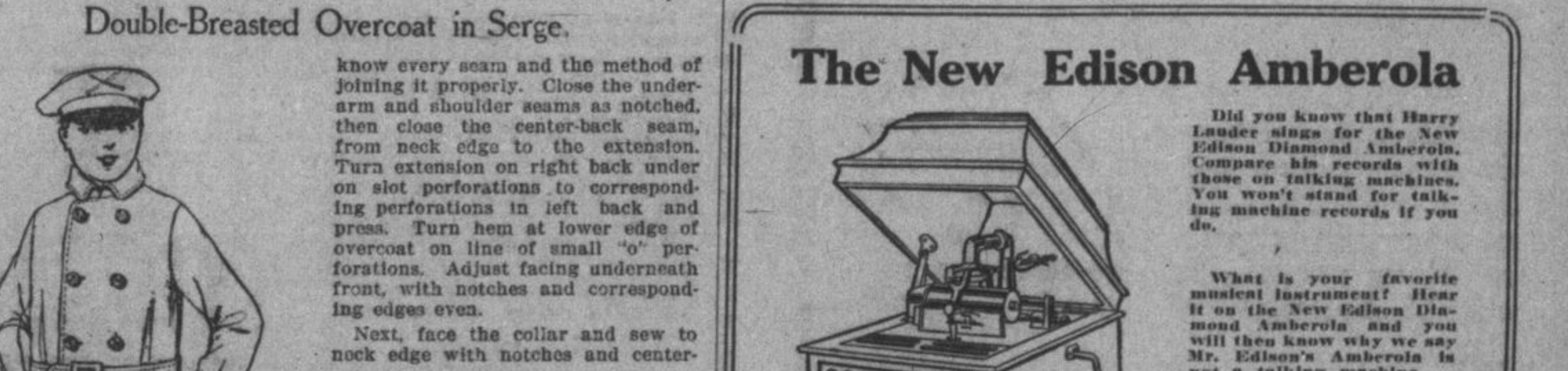

know every seam and the method of joining it properly. Close the under-arm and shoulder seams as notched, then close the center-back seam, from neck edge to the extension. Turn extension on right back under on slot perforations to corresponding perforations in left back and press. Turn hem at lower edge of overcoat on line of small "o" perforations. Adjust facing underneath front, with notches and corresponding edges even.  
Next, face the collar and sew to neck edge with notches and center-back even. Roll collar high, or roll collar and fronts as illustrated.  
Underface the pocket from upper edge to 1 inch below the small "o" perforations and roll top of pocket over small "o" perforations to form a lap. Adjust to position on front of overcoat, with upper edge at indicating small "o" perforations and stitch side and lower edges to position.  
To make the sleeves, close seams as notched, easing any fullness between the notches at elbow. Turn hem at lower edge on small "o" perforations. Cut 4 straps of material 2 inches long and 1/2 inch wide (when finished), use 2 for each sleeve. Adjust straps on under sleeve section (E) between the indicating small "o" perforations. Slip trimming band through the straps. Finish with a buckle and lap the ends to the desired amount. Sew space in armhole as notched with small "o" perforation at shoulder seam easing in any fullness at top of sleeve between the seams, or the fullness may be shrunk out. Hold the sleeves toward you when basing it in armhole.  
Now, line the belt and arrange around the waist, for the finishing touch.
