Jackets Show a Tendency to Taper.
season, but none more fashionable than that gained by the use of the peplum with the lower front edges tapering in points. A semi-dressy model is shown here. The jacket is a single-breasted model with high neck and standing collar rolled over at the top. Plaits take up the fullness at the front, the back being semi-fitted. Two circular peplum sections, the upper extending in deep points at the front and the under reaching across the back of jacket only, are unusual features of the design. Medium size requires 2 1/2 yards 54-inch material.
To give the proper lines to the jacket, first study the cutting guide to see how each section is laid on the material. For instance, the peplum section marked "I" is placed near the fold, but the large "O" perforations rest on a lengthwise thread of the material. The shawl collar and the back are the only two sections of the jacket that are laid along the lengthwise fold, being marked by "T" and "TTT" perforations, respectively.
Both sleeve sections, the pocket, side back, front and peplum section "L" are placed on the material with large "O" perforations on a lengthwise thread of material. The belt may be placed on either a lengthwise or crosswise fold of material.
If desired, silk, satin or some contrasting fabric may be used for the collar. The pattern is laid on the material in the same way, however.
