### IRISHMEN CONDEMNED TREASON MONGERS

"Gross Insult to Race," Declares Resolution Passed By Hibernians  
New York, June 21.—A demand that the Government "stamp out the propaganda of treason and sedition which is being openly conducted under the guise of Irish patriotism," was made in resolution adopted here by the Ancient Order of Hibernians, Division No. 9.  
The resolutions, which, it was said, would have "the support of 95 per cent. of our race," were telegraphed to President Wilson.  
The Hibernians declared that "the acts of certain gentlemen of our race in this country, and particularly New York, whose sincerity and motives we have good reason to doubt have brought about a condition by which the loyalty of the Irish race is on trial before the tribunal of American public opinion." These "acts" the Division condemned as "un-American and a gross insult" to Irishmen who, in the present and former wars, have offered their lives for the American cause.  
The town of Warner, Mann, was almost completely wiped out by a fire which did \$250,000 damage.
