BODY IDENTIFIED.
Brockville Man Loses Life In St. Lawrence River.
Ogdensburg, N.Y., July 22.—The body found on the shore of the St. Lawrence river west of this city was identified as that of Albert Langley, Brockville, drowned with a comrade when they and Langley's brother were returning late at night from this city to Brockville.
The body of another unidentified man was discovered on the Canadian shore near Prescott. It is believed the body is that of Leonard Watkins, who perished when Langley met his death. Emery Langley and Watkins were members of the 156th Battalion.

HE GAVE THE WARNING.

Of the Destruction of the Parliament Buildings, Ottawa.
Chicago, July 22.—The assertion that the late Victoriano Huerta, President of Mexico, came to the United States after he was ousted from the presidency in the interests of the German Government and with the intent to cause war between Mexico and this country, was made on the witness stand to-day by Gaston B. Means, H. also testified he had warned the Government officials of the destruction of the Parliament Buildings at Ottawa.
Japanese Diplomatic Council has agreed to the joint intervention by the Japanese and the United States in Siberia. A proclamation will be issued assuring Russia the Entente has no aggressive designs. It is probable a relief commission will accompany the joint expedition.
The Provincial Machinists' Convention renews Hon. Mr. Crothers' threat to arrest labor men in Windsor calling for a general strike.


