British Bomb Zeppelin Sheds

Airships in Schleswig Destroyed, Together With Airdromes.
London, July 23.—British sea-patrols launched from naval vessels near the coast of Germany, have dropped bombs on Teutonic airship sheds at Hondera, in Schleswig, destroying two sheds and possibly a third building, the British Admiralty announced. According to a Copenhagen despatch two Zeppelins were burned.
Four machines of the British aerial

squadron did not return, three landing in Danish territory. All the British warships returned to their base without any casualties.

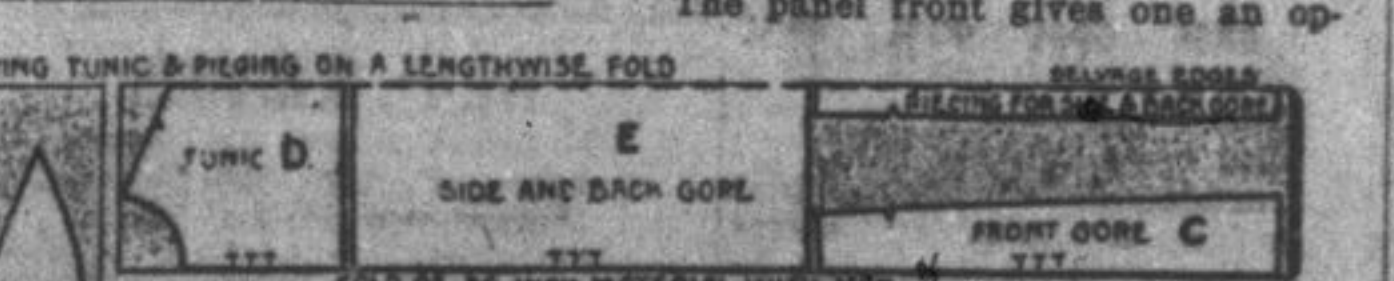
A Dressy Skirt for Summer Silks.

There are many graceful and exceedingly attractive models for separate skirts, especially those developed in the fashionable silks and satins. For a model that is not too fancy, yet far enough from the regulation type to be distinctive, the skirt illustrated is recommended. It is a two-piece model, with high waistline. The closing is to the left of the center-piece, the side and back gores being cut in one. A one-piece circular tunic, caught to the waist, the skirt, falls in cascade effect at the back, while the front is in panel effect. Foulard, charmeuse, tricotine, sports satin or taffeta would make up the skirt acceptably. 3 1/2 yards 36-inches wide being required for medium size.

The cutting guide supplied for the benefit of the home dressmaker shows how to cut the tunic and piece on a lengthwise fold of material. The piecing for the tunic is placed on an open width, while the tunic and side and back gores have the triple "T" perforations resting on a lengthwise fold of the silk. The front gore, to the right of the back, is also laid along the lengthwise fold. Opposite this, with straight edges along the selvage, is the piecing for side and back gore.

If the tunic is desired shorter than is shown, cut off the lower part along small "u" perforations.

The panel front gives one an opportunity to add braiding or embroidery, both of which play an important part in the decoration of separate skirts this season.
