PROCLAMATION

Fourth Anniversary of Declaration of War

John M. Hughes, Mayor of the City of Kingston.

Whereas the Imperial Government has requested that the Anniversaries of the Declaration of War should be fittingly recognized throughout the Empire, and, believing that the citizens of Kingston are firm in their convictions as to the righteousness of the cause for which the Empire is fighting

I do hereby request that Sunday, the 4th day of August next, be observed as the fourth anniversary of the war

And in accordance with the wish of the Imperial authorities I would most respectfully ask the clergy of every denomination throughout the city to hold appropriate

Divine Services

In their respective churches on that day for the purpose of stimulating devotion and patriotism, and where possible resolutions be passed setting forth the inflexible determination to continue to a victorious end the struggle in maintenance of those ideals of liberty and justice which are the common and sacred cause of the Allies.

In witness thereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused this proclamation to be made known.
