Keep Engine Nuts Tight.
 It is a good plan to draw up the studs of nuts holding down the cylinders of the motor from time to time, and also to adjust similarly those which hold the engine to the frame. Even so slight an amount of play as may be permitted by a half turn of slackness may be enough to put a tremendous and wholly unnecessary strain on the parts, especially when the slackness is local and exists only in one or two points of the system. Lost motion between stationary parts may be quite as injurious as that between those which move. It is not so much the possible play as the concentration of a load on the remaining fastenings which is to be guarded against.
