FOR POLAND'S FREEDOM

Poles in Siberia Plan to Raise an Army.
Harbin, Sept. 18.—A movement exceeding, perhaps that of the Czech-Slovaks' is being organized by Polish officers to form a Polish division to fight in Siberia westward to their oppressed fatherland as irregular units in the American army. According to conservative estimates an army of more than 100,000 trained militiamen is immediately available in the regions of Harbin, Nikolai and Vladivostok.

HUN DIVISIONS DISBANDED
Huns Cut Out 108 Battalions to Cover Losses.
With the American Army on the Metz Front, Sept. 18.—It is established that the Germans already have disbanded 108 infantry battalions, equivalent to twelve divisions, to make up the losses resulting from the year's fighting. Five thousand women are being mobilized for certain auxiliary service. Boys of fifteen also are being used.
