London, Oct. 11.—The Marquis of Lansdowne, famous for his peace letters, in a statement on the German peace offer, said yesterday that he regarded it as the most substantial advance yet made by the Central Powers. He considered the stipulations which President Wilson had made in reply as reasonable.

In his opinion it would be out of the question to interrupt the campaign, which was proceeding successfully on every front, and thereby give the enemy breathing space and opportunity to consolidate his resources, without amply sufficient guarantees of the kind the President demanded.
