MAY USE MAJOR PARKS.

Government Approves of Plan for Week-end Baseball.

The U. S. Government has approv-ed the plan of the National Baseball Federation to form a -semi-professional league to play in major league parks on Saturdays and Sundays next

The league will be comprised of teams representing eight cities; including Chicago, Detroit, Cleveland, Pittsburg, Cincinnati and Akron. The remaining two are yet to be selected. Each city will have at least two clubs, one remaining at home while the other is on the road. After travelling expenses and the up-keep of the parks have been deducted the receipts will go to the national commission on training camp activities for athletic equipment for soldiers and sailors.
