(Continued from Page 1.) under the armistice terms eight of the remainder have to be given up, leaving only a very feeble few to the enemy.

In regard to destroyers, Germany in 1914 possessed 133 of these vessels, with no modern torpedo vessels. The number of these which have been sunk cannot for the present be accurately computed, but it can safely be said that more than half of the destroyer flotillas have been sent to the bottom.
