## PHYSICAL CRISIS IS OVER IN BERLIN

Order Maintained With Iron Hand—Robbers Are Immediately Executed.

Amsterdam, Nov. 19.—A Berlin telegram under date of Nov. 13th which has been received here, says that during the twenty-four hours before its despatch, not a shot had been fired in Berlin and that the physical crisis appeared to be over. Order, it is said, was maintained with an iron hand and robbery was punished by immediate execution. At that time the life of the city was returning to normal.

Delegates from all soldiers' councils met in the reichstag chamber on Friday to discuss the institution of the Red Guard. The proceedings were enlivened by divergencies of opinion, some advocating the Red Guard as civil protection and others opposing the plan as implying lack of confidence in the soldiers. Friedrich Ebert, the premier, frankly declared in an address there was no necessity for the Red Guard.

The Canadian Railway War Board has granted the Great North-western Telegraph operators an increase on the same basis as the C. P. R. increase to begin on September 1st last.

Three Quebec newspapers, the Telegraph, Le Soleil and L'Action Catholique, have increased their price to two cents. L'Evenement is now the only daily here selling at one cent.
