A MEMORIAL AT QUEEN'S

TO GRADUATES AND UNDERGRADUATES WHO GAVE LIVES.

In the Great War—The Nature of the Memorial Has Not Yet Been Decided Upon.

The establishment of some memorial to the memory of Queen's graduates and undergraduates who have given their lives in the great war, has been under consideration for some time. As yet it is uncertain what form the memorial is to take, but the matter was discussed at the last meeting of the Alma-Mater Society of Queen's and a motion was put before the house to ascertain from the University Senate what steps, if any have been taken by them in connection with erecting a memorial.

Several forms of memorial have already been suggested, such as arches and tablets, but the latest is to establish a scholarship fund for returned soldiers and their near relatives.

The originator of this scheme is A. Pan L. Serson, himself a returned soldier of three years' service, and whose brother, John H. Serson, a former student of Queen's, was recently killed in action. It is suggested that voluntary contributions be asked for the fund and invested, so that the interest will yield sufficient for perpetual scholarships. It is proposed that this fund be started at once, and that for a few years the scholarship be open to returned soldiers only, afterwards to their near relatives and dependents.

Many soldiers of matriculation standing, and some who have already spent some time at college, feel that there is now sufficient inducement to enter college when they can secure remunerative employment on stepping out of uniform. Scholarships, it is urged, would attract many to Queen's who otherwise would not continue.

Military News

A special troop train, having on board four officers and two hundred other ranks from the S.S. Empress of Britain for Military District No. 3, left Halifax on Wednesday afternoon. The train should reach Kingston on Friday.

The S.S. Essiquibo, having on board two officers and forty-eight other ranks for Queen's Military Hospital, is due to arrive in Halifax on Thursday.

The men of the Engineers Training Depot, Brockville, will come to Barrield camp on Friday for demobilization.

Lieut.-Col. G. H. Gillespie presided at a court of inquiry into the death of the late Sergt. Patrick Gordon, of the 3rd Battalion, C.G.R., who lost his life from drinking wood alcohol and whose death was the subject of an inquest held last week.

Greater care is to be taken at the railway stations during the arrival of soldiers. An area is to be roped off to prevent crowds swarming against the cars and a stand will be erected for the reception committee in order that the programme may not be interrupted. Citizens will have ample opportunity to meet their relatives and friends after the formal welcoming has taken place. The troops will be officially taken over from the conducting officer on the train between Montreal and Kingston, an officer being sent to Montreal for that purpose.

The 38th, 2nd, 21st and Princess Patricia Canadian Light Infantry form what is known officially as the Eastern Ontario Regiment, the personnel of which is drawn entirely from Ottawa, Kingston and eastern counties of Ontario. The commanding officers of these battalions are Lieut.-Col. A. D. Cameron, 38th; Lieut.-Col. E. A. McLaughlin, 2nd Battalion; Lieut.-Col. H. E. Poole, 21st Battalion; and Lieut.-Col. Hamilton Gault, Princess Patricia's.

Nick Bawif, who left Kingston as a lieutenant, is now a captain in the Canadian Army Pay Corps and is with the 3rd Canadian divisional train in Germany.

NO APPEAL IN CASE OF LOCAL PHYSICIAN

Who Was Found "Not Guilty" of Giving Liquor For Beverage Purposes.

Although at the time Magistrate Parrat's decision, it was stated that an appeal would be entered in this case of a local physician, who was charged with giving liquor as a beverage, it is now understood that no appeal will be made. If an appeal is to be made there is plenty of time, as the time allowed is thirty days after the decision is given. The Whig was given to understand on Wednesday that there would be no appeal entered.

It is of interest to note that following the hearing of this case, and the rendering of judgment, the Government announced that there would be a change made in the handling of liquor. This, no doubt, has had something to do with the fact that no appeal is to be entered.
