BARE KNUCKLE MEN WERE REAL FIGHTERS

Scrappers of Bygone Days Noted for Ability to Stand Punishment.

Joe Grimm, George Siddons, Jack Burke, Andy Bowen, Danny Needham, and other modern ring warriors have proved themselves to belong to the "iron man" class by taking part in long and desperate battles, but for real durability under punishment we have to go back to the old bare knuckle days of the ring.

One of the most celebrated of the old-time "iron men" was Mike Madden. Although he never became champion, and his very name is almost forgotten, Mike deserves to be remembered as the hero of two of the longest battles ever fought in the ring. It is seventy years ago since Mike figured in one of the most historic, but not the longest of those bloody conflicts of the raw 'uns. On December 12, 1848, at Woking, England, he defeated Jack Grant in a battle of 140 rounds, lasting five hours and three quarters. Although both men were terribly punished and barely able to stand, they fought on until darkness forced them to stop. Madden had the best of the argument, and Grant was in a sorry plight when he was led away at the conclusion of hostilities. Grant had a long rest, and when he returned to the ring he was whipped by Tom Sayers, the "Little Wonder," who afterwards fought John C. Heenan for the world's title.

About seven months after the Grant battle, Mike Madden fought his historic battle with Bill Hayes, a prominent fighter of that period, at Edinbridge, England. This contest went 185 rounds and lasted six hours and three minutes. It was the longest bare knuckle battle ever fought, with the exception of a bare knuckle contest staged at Melbourne in 1855, when Jim Kelly and Jonathan Smith fought six hours and fifteen minutes.

Only one man in ring history ever fought two battles of longer duration. Andy Bowen, the New Orleans mulatto boxer, exceeded Mike Madden's record in 1853, when he fought

seven hours and fifteen minutes with Jack Burke, and then a few weeks later, defeated Jack Everhardt in five hours and thirty-eight minutes. These were glove contests, however, and the participants did not take nearly as much punishment as did the old "iron men" who fought with the raw 'uns.

Miss Grace Fulkerson, Canadian women's champion, lowered the colors of the Detroiters in the first heat of the state championship race for women skaters at the Palace Gardens rink. Edna Fredette was second, and Edna Schewe third. The time was 1:54.

A CHOICE OF TWO.

Rowland or Heinie Groh May Manage the Reds.
The question as to the successor of Christy Mathewson, as manager of the Reds, in the event that Matty doesn't return from France in the near future, appears to have narrowed down to Clarence Rowland and Heinie Groh. President August Herrmann of the Reds has heard considerable about the ability of Rowland, who has been recommended by several prominent baseball men. Groh is a big favorite with Cincinnati fans, who recently gave a big demonstration in his honor to make it plain that they wanted him for manager. But Herrmann is said to fear that Heinie will lose some of his remarkable ability as a player if he is burdened with the extra responsibilities as manager of the club.

Noteworthy Performance.

There were two noteworthy performances in the weight-carrying line on New York tracks this year. In the Grab Bag Handicap at Saratoga, that remarkable gelding, Billy Kelly, defeated a crack field with 155 pounds in the saddle, winning with plenty to spare. This performance so impressed Handicapper W. S. Vosburgh that in assigning the weights for the Adirondack Handicap he asked Billy Kelly to take up 140 pounds, the greatest burden ever inflicted upon a two-year-old in the history of American racing. The other weight-carrying feat was performed by Polymellon, which equalled the Saratoga track record of 1:10 2-5 for the six furlongs with 140 pounds on his back.

Moran May Succeed McGraw.

But Moran, who was signed by the Giants for the coming season at a salary of \$5000, will be more than a mere coach of pitchers with the club. He will take much of the detail of running the team off the hands of John J. McGraw. It things break as McGraw hopes they will, Moran will be elevated to the full leadership. The acquisition of Moran gives the Giants two men who have won pennants in the National League. No matter what happens, the club is protected, from a managerial standpoint.
