Ottawa, March 13.—The cost of living in Edmonton for a widow and three children is \$1,751 per annum, according to Mayor Joseph A. Clarke. A petition for an increase in pensions for war widows and their families in the Edmonton district was laid before the Pensions Committee of Parliament, and the cost of living for such a family was placed at the figure mentioned. The mayor endorsed this figure in a letter which was read, and described it as "very moderate." It does not include any allowances for pleasure or recreation. The scale was referred to the labor department for report.
