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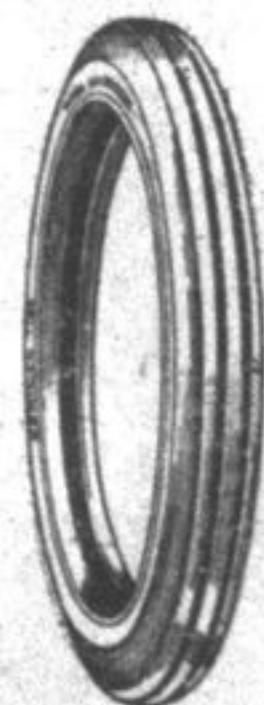

He dropped the axe to the floor, near the table while he was eating. Mr. Ettinger made the remark to the convict that he should not be carrying the axe around with him, and put the axe away for safe keeping. The convict made no protest. While the fellow was eating his lunch Mrs. Ettinger got word to the penitentiary that the missing man was at her home.

Threw Up His Hands.
George Laturney, employed as a clerk in the warden's office, went to the house, and while he entered the house, with a loaded revolver, a former guard at the penitentiary, I. McCue, and a soldier, who helped in the search, remained on guard on the outside. Mr. Laturney went into the house via the front door. Mr. Ettinger told him that his man was in the kitchen, and with the loaded revolver in his hand, Mr. Laturney made for the kitchen, but the convict had notified him coming, and bolted for the back door. Mr. Laturney went on through to the back door, and as he reached the yard, he ordered the prisoner to give himself up. He kept on going, and then Mr. Laturney fired a shot near the man. doubt if he had not been handled with care, he would have used violence. Mr. Laturney also displayed nerve in corraling the convict, as at the time he entered the house he did not know but that the convict had firearms. It is understood that this is the first serious trouble Rogers has figured in since he came to the prison. He had almost two years of his seven served, and with good conduct would have been out in a comparatively short time. Now he has placed himself in the position of having to answer to two serious charges, that of assaulting a guard, and attempting to escape, with a far more serious charge, should Guard Berrigan succumb to his injuries.

Received Terrible Wounds.
After receiving first aid at penitentiary hospital, Guard Berrigan was removed to the Hotel Dieu, where he was attended by the penitentiary surgeon, Dr. Robert Hanley, and Dr. D. E. Mundell. He suffered one knife wound in his stomach below his heart.

The wounded guard is married, and has a wife and family residing in Livingston. He has been a guard at the prison for about fifteen years, having been appointed on Nov. 1st, 1904. He is fifty-one years old, and a brother of Michael Berrigan of the Whitney hotel, a former member of the Kingston police force.

Officers Saw Convict.
It was learned that Capt. Morrison and McNab, military chaplains, noticed the convict thru an out-building when they were on duty, but they did not know who the man was, or why he was in the building. They did not know at the time, that a convict had escaped.

This is the most sensational escape from the prison since the famous Meem Bros. and two other pals, about seven years ago, assaulted one of the keepers and then attacked the man on the main gate of the prison and walked out. On this occasion, all the convicts who got away, were rounded up in quick order and returned to the prison, and all had long terms added to their former sentence. They were tried before Judge Madden. Citizens will recall the sensational case.
