

HOME FROM OVERSEAS.

Lieut.-Col. J. C .Stewart, D.S.O., Had Most Distinguished Career. Among the men from overseas t arrive home on Monday forenoon was one who won great distinction on the Crossley Stewart, D.S.O., son of Postmaster James Stewart. His work in the war stands out with special prominence. He served as a private in the P. O. W. Rifles, and graduated at the Royal Military College in 1911, at twenty gears of age. He received a commission in the 8th Field Battery, Gananoque. He captain of his battery when the war broke out, and with his senior officer. Major Britton, volunteered for ser-He was seconded as captain to the 3rd, Battery, 1st Brigade, C.F.A., C.E.F., and in that capacity trained at Valcartier and Salisbury Plain, and passed over to France. 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
